ORDINANCE NO. 14

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING AN ANNUAL PERMIT FROM THE CITY MAYOR FOR THE CONSTRUCTION AND/OR OPERATION OF RAILROADS OR RAILWAYS CROSSING PUBLIC HIGHWAYS AND PROVINCIAL, MUNICIPAL, BARRIO, VECINAL AND FEEDER ROADS OR THE LIKE WITHIN THE TERRITORIAL JURISDICTION OF ORMOC CITY, PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF

AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

BE IT ORDAINED, by authority of the Municipal Board of 6rmoc City, Philippines, pursuant to the provisions of Republic Act 179, as amended by Republic Act 429, otherwise known as the Charter of Ormoc City, That:

SECTION 1. Any person, partnership, firm, corporation or entity and the like desiring to construct and/or operate a railroad or railway crossing public highways and provincial, municipal, barrio, vecinal and feeder roads or the like within the territorial jurisdiction of Ormoc City shall first secure the necessary permit from the Office of the City Mayor.

SECTION 2. For purposes of this Ordinance, all existing railroads or railways shall be considered as new.

SECTION 3. Any violation of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be punishable by an imprisonment of not less than fifteen (15) days but not exceeding thirty (30) days or a fine of Two Hundred Pesos (\$\mathbb{P}200) or both such imprisonment and fine at the discretion of the court. If the violation is committed by a firm or corporation, the manager or the managing director or person charged with the management of such firm or corporation shall be held criminally liable or responsible therefor.

SECTION 4. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval.
