"RESOLVED, to adopt:

ORDINANCE NO. 15

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING ANNUAL PERMITS FROM AND INSPECTIONS FROM TIME TO TIME AS PUBLIC INTEREST SO DEMANDS BY THE OFFICE OF THE CITY MAYOR ON ALL INDUSTRIAL ESTABLISHMENTS IN ORMOC CITY, REGULATING THE BILGING OF SMOKE, FLYING EMBERS, ASHES, SOOTS AND THE LIKE FROM THEIR CHIMNEYS OR SMOKESTACKS, PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

BE IT ORDAINED, by authority of the Municipal Board of Ormoc City, Philippines, pursuant to the provisions of Republic Act 179, as amended by Republic Act 429, otherwise known as the Charter of Ormoc City, That:

SECTION 1. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm, partnership, corporation or entity and the like to operate an industrial establishment in Ormoc City without first securing the necessary annual permit from the Office of the City Mayor.

SECTION 2. The Office of the City Mayor shall conduct or cause to conduct an inspection of chimneys or smokestacks of industrial establishments subject to this Ordinance before issuing a permit for the operation of such bstablishments: PROVIDED, HOWEVER, that inspections may be made from time to time as public interest so demands.

SECTION 3. For purposes of this Ordinance, all industrial establishments now existing with chimneys or smokestacks and the like shall be considered as new.

SECTION 4. All industrial establishments subject to this Ordinance shall follow strictly all safety rules and regulations promulgated in any and all national laws and/or local ordinances.

SECTION 5. All industrial establishments having chimneys or smokestacks and the like shall provide themselves with arrester to regulate or eliminate as much as possible the bilging of smoke, flying embers, ashes or soots from such chimneys or smokestacks.

SECTION 6. Any violation of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be punishable by an imprisonment of thirty (30) days and a fine of Two Hundred Pesos (P200). If the violation is committed by a firm or corporation, the manager or managing director or person charged with the management of the industrial establishment shall be criminally responsible or liable therefor.

SECTION 7. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.


SECTION 8. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval.






