## ORDINANCE NO. 17

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE THROWING, DISPOSING, DEPOSITING AND/OR LEAVING OF OBSTACLES LIABLE TO CAUSE DAMAGE OR POLLUTION OF CANALS, STREAMS, BROOKS, RIVERS, WATERS, SEA OR COASTAL WATERS AND THE LIKE IN ORMOC CITY AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF

BE IT ORDAINED, by authority of the Municipal Board of Ormoc City, Philippines, pursuant to the provisions of Republic Act 179, as amended by Republic Act 429, otherwise known as the Charter of Ormoc City, That:

SECTION 1. It shall be unlawful for any person or persons, partner—ship, firm, corporation or entity and the like to throw, dispose of, deposit and/or leave obstacles liable to cause damage or pollution of canals, streams, brooks, rivers, waters, sea or coastal waters and the like within the territorial jurisdiction of Ormoc City any kind of obstacle, offal, garbage, refuse, bagasse and other offensive matter to health and sanitation.

For purposes of this Ordinance, by refuse is meant "any used oils and any wastermaterials of any kind."

SECTION 2. Refuse or garbage shall be thrown, disposed of, deposited and/or left in a place where they may be burned in any manner not offensive to public health and sanitation and not to cause damage or pllution of canals, streams, brooks, rivers, waters, sea or coastal waters and the like.

SECTION 3. Any violation of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be punishable by an imprisonment of not less than four (4) months but not exceeding six (6) months or a fine of not less than One Hundred Pesos (\$\mathbb{P}\$200) but not exceeding Two Hundred Pesos (\$\mathbb{P}\$200) or both such imprisonment and fine at the discretion of the court. If the violation is committed by a firm or corporation, the manager or managing director or person charged with the management of the business of such firm or corporation shall be criminally responsible or liable therefor.

SECTION 4. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.



SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval.
