ORDINANCE NO. 18

Res. 129-Ord 39-4-17-68

AN ORDINANCE IMPOSING A LICENSE FEE OF TWO HUNDRED PESOS (P200)
UPON ANY DULY LICENSED ENGINEER EMPLOYED IN INDUSTRIAL
ESTABLISHMENTS USING STEAM ENGINES AND/OR BOILERS AND
PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF

BE IT ORDAINED, by authority of the Municipal Board of Ormoc City,
Philippines, pursuant to the provisions of Republic Act 179, as amended
by Republic Act 429, otherwise known as the Charter of Ormoc City, That:

SECTION 1. License fee. - There shall be paid to the City Treasurer
an annual license fee of Two Hundred Pesos (P200) by any duly licensed
engineer employed in any industrial establishment using steam engines
and/or boilers.

SECTION 2. Time and manner of payment and penalty for delinquency.
- The license fee herein prescribed shall be payable without penalty
within twenty (20) days from the beginning of every calendar year for
which the fee is due. Failure to pay the license fee within the pres-
cribed period shall subject the taxpayer subject to a surcharge of
twenty-five percentum (25) from January 21 to June 30 and fifty per-
centum (50%) from July 1 to December 31 of the calendar year for which
the fee is due: PROVIDED, HOWEVER, That payment due for this calendar
year (1965) shall be made at the second quarter of this said calendar
year, and subseautent payments shall be made within the first twenty
(20) days of every succeeding calendar year as provided for herein.

SECTION 3. Penalty for violation. - Any violation of the provie-
sions of this Ordinance shall be punishable by an imprisonment of not
less than thirty (30) days but not exceeding six (6) months or a fine
of Two Hundred Pesos or both such imprisonment and fine (P200) at the
discretion of the court.

SECTION 4. Repeal. - All ordinances or parts of ordinances incon-
sistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed or
modified accordingly.

SECTION 5. Effectivity. - This Ordinance shall take effect imme-
diately upon its approval


