RESOLUTION NO. 105

"WHEREAS, under his 1st Indorsement dated January 15, 1965, the City Engineer has called the attention of this august Body to the necessity of appropriating the sum of \$\mathbb{P}25,234.00\$ from the unexpended general fund of this City to constitute its counterpart fund for the maintenance of national-provincial (city) "JJ" roads and bridges as called for in a BPH Memorandum dated March 17, 1964, otherwise, this City shall stand to lose its national government aid of the same sum;

"WHEREAS, on Sheet 8 of the Trial Balance of the City Treasurer as of June 30, 1964, there appears an "Unappropriated Accounts of \$\frac{1}{2}4,484.72\$ from the road and bridge fund, which this august Body, under Resolutions Nos. 345 and 346, embodying Ordinances Nos. 44 and 45, respectively, series of 1964, reverted to the general fund and forthwith expended for payment of road-right-of-way claims without the prerequisite certification of the Commissioner of Public Highways, as provided for by law, that said "Unappropriated Account" is no longer needed for road and bridge purposes, thereby rendering said Resolution-Ordinances devoid of force and effect;

"WHEREAS, under a certification dated April 30, 1964, the City Treasurer informed this august Body of an unappropriated balance of the general fund of \$\mathbb{P}\$1,365.05 only, hence, the failure of the City to set aside \$\mathbb{P}\$25,234.00 required by the above-mentioned BPH Memorandum as counterpart fund;

"RESOLVED, to reseired Resolutions Nos. 345 and 346, embodying Ordinances Nos. 44 and 45, respectively, series of 1964, and in their stead adopt:

ORDINANCE NO. 41-

AN ORDINANCE REVERTING THE AMOUNT OF \$749.26 FROM SALARY SAVINGS IN THE CITY INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL FUND, 1964-1965 ORMOC CITY BUDGET, AND INCORPORATING THE SAME TO THE UNAPPROPRIATED ACCOUNT OF \$24,484.72 FROM THE ROAD AND BRIDGE FUND TO MEET THE COUNTERPART FUND REQUIREMENT OF \$25,234.00 PER BPH MEMORANDUM DATED MARCH 17, 1964, FOR THE MAINTENANCE OF NATIONAL—PROVINCIAL (CITY) "JJ" ROADS AND BRIDGES OF ORMOC CITY, INCLUDING THE PURCHASE OF NECESSARY MATERIALS, SUPPLIES AND EQUIPMENT

BE IT ORDAINED, by authority of the Municipal Board of Ormoc City, Philippines, pursuant to the provisions of Republic Act 179, as amended by Republic Act 429, otherwise known as the Charter of Ormoc City, That:

SECTION 1. The amount of \$749.26 or so much thereof is hereby reverted from salary savings in the Intermediate School Fund, Ormoc City Budget of 1964-1965, to be incorporated to the unappropriated account of \$24,484.72 from the Road and Bridge Fund to meet the counterpart fund requirement of \$25,234.00 per BPH Memorandum dated March 17, 1964, for the maintenance of national-provincial (city) "JJ" roads and bridges in Ormoc City, including the purchase of necessary materials, supplies and equipment.

SECTION 2. The City Treasurer is hereby authorized to issue a certification of availability of funds in connection with the foregoing appropriation to put up this City's counterpart fund referred to in the preceding section hereof.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval.

Tan, House of Representatives, both of Manila, the Division Engineer, 4th Engineering Division, Cebu City, and the City Engineer, the City Treasurer and the City Auditor, all of Ormoc City;
