"RESOLVED, to adopt:

ORDINANCE NO. 46

AN ORDINANCE REVERTING ₱684.39 FROM SALARY SAVINGS IN THE  
INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL FUND, 1964-1965 ORMOC CITY BUDGET,  
FOR THE RECONSTRUCTION AND/OR IMPROVEMENT OF THE CITY  
STAGE

BE IT ORDAINED, by authority of the Municipal Board, Ormoc City,  
Philippines, pursuant to the provisions of Republic Act 179, as amended  
by Republic Act 429, otherwise known as the Charter of Ormoc City, That:

SECTION 1. The sum of ₱684.39 or so much thereof is hereby reverted  
from out of the salary savings in the Intermediate School Fund, 1964-65  
Ormoc City Budget, to be made available for appropriation for the recon-  
struction and/or improvement of the city stage in accordance with the es-  
timates of the City Engineer.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its  
approval.
