RESOLUTION NO. 137

"WHEREAS, this august Body has committed itself to the people of Ormoc City for various projects to the benefit and welfare of the City in general among which is the improvement of city roads and streets;

"WHEREAS, it has been a long dream of our constituents from the communities of Alegria to Nauñgan to have a better road ever since before the War;

"WHEREAS, this august Body would like to make good its commitment to the people of Ormoc, particularly, the people in the communities from Alegria to Nauñgan so much so that we find it high time now to pave the road from Alegria to Nauñgan which will also redound to the benefit of the people of Batuan, Punta and Linao communities;

"WHEREAS, this Board feels the urgency, also, of paving the access road from the national highway in Valencia to its public market in answer to the clamor of a great number of our constituents from that community;

"WHEREAS, upon consultations with the City Engineer it has been estimated that (the) to realize these projects would entail an expenditure of no less than Eighty-Eight Thousand Pesos (P88,000.00) as this Body contemplates to pave the roads aforementioned with asphalt;

"WHEREAS, expenditures for projects of this kind, pursuant to provisions of law, are commonly shared by the National and City Governments by way of putting up fifty-fifty counterpart funds;

"NOW, THEREFORE, the Board, on motion of Councilor Du, seconded by the Presiding Officer, the Floor Leader, and all the Councilors;

"RESOLVED, vigorously to request the Honorable Commissioner of Public Highways to put up a national counterpart fund in the amount of Forty-Four Thousand Pesos (P44,000.00) to be made available for appropriation for the asphaltting of the Alegria-Nauñgan Road and of the access road from the national highway in Valencia to the Valencia Public Market;

"RESOLVED, FURTHER, to adopt:

ORDINANCE NO. 49

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF FORTY-FOUR THOUSAND PESOS (P44,000.00) TO CONSTITUTE A CITY COUNTERPART FUND FOR THE ASPHALTING OF THE ALEGRIA-NAUÑGAN ROAD AND OF THE ACCESS ROAD FROM THE NATIONAL HIGHWAY IN VALENCIA COMMUNITY TO THE VALENCIA PUBLIC MARKET

BE IT ORDAINED, by authority of the Municipal Board of Ormoc City, Philippines, pursuant to the provisions of Republic Act 179, as amended by Republic Act 429, otherwise known as the Charter of Ormoc City, That:

SECTION 1. The sum of Forty-Four Thousand Pesos (P44,000.00) or so much thereof is hereby appropriated from funds not otherwise appropriated in the city treasury to be made available for a city counterpart fund for the asphaltting of the Alegria-Nauñgan Road and of the access road from the national highway in Valencia community to the Valencia Public Market.

SECTION 2. The City Treasurer is hereby authorized to issue a certification of availability of funds in connection with the foregoing appropriation to put up this City's counterpart fund referred to in Section 1 hereof.


SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval.

"CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY."




