RESOLUTION NO. 202

"WHEREAS, this august Body will remember having passed Resolution No. 161 on June 30, 1965, adopting Ordinance No. 56, appropriating the sum of ₱9,000 for freight, insurance, inspection and other charges against Ormoc City for five jeeps and one fire truck from the Reparations Commission, Japan, through the National Civil Defense Administration, Manila;

"WHEREAS, the Assistant City Treasurer, with reference to the aforementioned resolution-ordinance, has reported that the appropriation for the charges against Ormoc City for the jeeps and fire truck has been reverted to the general fund with the close of the books of account at the end of the 1964-1965 fiscal year so much so that the said resolution-ordinance has prescribed, thus, prompting this august Body to pass another resolution with the same intent and purpose of our Resolution No. 161, current series, considering that the Acting City Treasurer has advised this Board that funds for the same could be well taken care of by the unexpended balance from the 1964-1965 Ormoc City Budget resulting from the reversion of funds at the close of the account books of the City Government for said fiscal year;

"NOW, THEREFORE, the Board, on motion of Councilor Abas, seconded by Councilor Alfaro;

"RESOLVED, to adopt:

ORDINANCE NO. 63

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF ₱9,000 OUT OF THE UNEXPENDED BALANCE FROM THE 1964-1965 ORMOC CITY BUDGET FOR INCORPORATION IN THE ENSUING 1965-1966 ORMOC CITY BUDGET TO BE MADE AVAILABLE FOR FREIGHT, INSURANCE, INSPECTION AND OTHER CHARGES AGAINST ORMOC CITY FOR FIVE JEEPS AND ONE FIRE TRUCK FROM THE REPARATIONS COMMISSION, JAPAN, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ORDAINED, by authority of the Municipal Board of Ormoc City, Philippines, pursuant to the provisions of Republic Act 179, as amended by Republic Act 429, otherwise known as the Charter of Ormoc City, That:

SECTION 1. The sum of Nine Thousand Pesos (₱9,000), or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of the unexpended balance from the 1964-1965 Ormoc City Budget for incorporation in the ensuing 1965-1966 Ormoc City Budget to be made available for freight, insurance, inspection and other charges against Ormoc City for five jeeps and one fire truck allotted free from the

Reparations Commission, Japan, through the National Civil Defense Administration, Manila, in the manner provided hereunder as follows:

a) Five (5) Reparation jeeps @ ₱1,000.00	₱ 5,000.00
b) One (1) Reparation fire truck	4,000.00
T o t a l	₱ 9,000.00

SECTION 2. The City Treasurer is hereby authorized to issue a certificate of the availability of funds and/or with the corresponding check payable to the National Civil Defense Administration, with the concurrence of the City Auditor, in the sum of Nine Thousand Pesos (₱9,000) provided for in Section 1 hereof.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval.


