ORDINANCE NO. 66

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$27,406.45 OUT OF THE UNEXPENDED BALANCE FROM THE 1964-1965 CHMOC CITY BUDGET TO BE MADE AVAILABLE FOR PAYMENT OF OUTSTANDING OBLIGATIONS CHARGED AGAINST VARIOUS DEPARTMENTS, BUREAUS AND OFFICES OF THE CITY GOVERNMENT.

BE IT ORDAINED, by authority of the Municipal Board of Ormoc City, Philippines, pursuant to the provisions of Republic Act 179, as amended by Republic Act 429, otherwise known as the Charter of Ormoc City, That:

SECTION 1. The sum of Twenty-size thousand four hundred six pesos and forty-five centaves (\$27,406.45), or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of the unexpended balance from the 1964-1965 Ormoc City Budget to be made available for payment of outstanding obligations charged against various departments, bureaus and offices of the City Government in the manner provided hereunder as follows:
