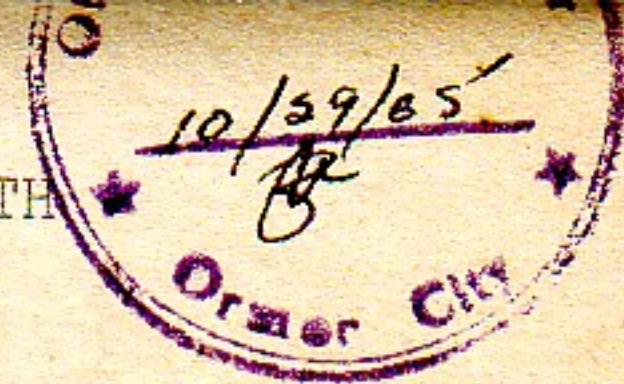


EXCERPT FROM THE MINUTES OF THE REGULAR SESSION OF THE FIFTH

ORDINANCE NO. 66

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING ₱27,406.45 OUT OF THE UNEXPENDED
BALANCE FROM THE 1964-1965 ORMOC CITY BUDGET TO BE MADE
AVAILABLE FOR PAYMENT OF OUTSTANDING OBLIGATIONS CHARGED
AGAINST VARIOUS DEPARTMENTS, BUREAUS AND OFFICES OF THE
CITY GOVERNMENT.

BE IT ORDAINED, by authority of the Municipal Board of Ormoc City,
Philippines, pursuant to the provisions of Republic Act 179, as amended
by Republic Act 429, otherwise known as the Charter of Ormoc City, That:

SECTION 1. The sum of ^{seven}Twenty-seven thousand four hundred six pesos
and forty-five centavos (₱27,406.45), or so much thereof as may be ne-
cessary, is hereby appropriated out of the unexpended balance from the
1964-1965 Ormoc City Budget to be made available for payment of out-
standing obligations charged against various departments, bureaus and
offices of the City Government in the manner provided hereunder as
follows:

1. Refund of payment made under protest for
inspection fees on livestock shipped to
Manila from 1954 to date by Mr. Antonio.

2. Road-Right-of-Way Claims on Lots Nos. 714
and 715 by Generosa Conui, et al, affect-
ed by the widening and paving of City
streets 7,710.00
3. Purchase of mercury vapor bulbs payable
to Goodwill Auto Supply 5,000.00
4. Light bills, for May and June, 1965,
Ormoc Electric Company, Inc. 3,278.80
5. Retirement Gratuity for Ex-Police First
Sergeant Severo Tomada per Item No. 44,
C-15, page 10, 1964-1965 City Budget 800.00
6. Salary difference of Editha L. Cortes,
Laborer, Office of the City Mayor from
₱4.00 a day to ₱120.00 per month for
the period from September 1, 1964, to
September 30, 1965 566.00

7. Unpaid salary of Pat. Matias Dawal, OCPD, at
P120.00 per month for the period from Jan.
13 to April 18, 1965, inclusive P. 385.00
8. Unpaid salary of Fireman Benedicto L. Cong-
son (OCFD) at P120.00 per month for the
period from September 16 to October 18,
1964, inclusive 128.00
9. To Serafica Sawmill for assorted sizes of
lumber for the Junior Basketball Court 126.12
10. Salary difference of Antonio Santa Cruz,
Building Inspector, Office of the City
Engineer from P140.00 to P150.00 per
month or at the rate of P10.00 per month
for the period from July 1, 1963, to
June 30, 1964, inclusive 120.00
11. Unpaid salary of Fireman Bonifacio Taneo
(OCFD) at P120.00 per month for the pe-
riod from April 13 to May 7, 1964, in-
clusive 96.00
12. Accrued vacation and sick leave of Ex-
Police Cpl. Manuel Arradaza (OCPD) at
P77.66 per month for the period from
Nov. 1, 1949, to Aug. 31, 1950, inclusive 61.82
13. Accrued vacation and sick leave of Ex-
Police Cpl. Buenaventura Tortugo at
P65.00 per month for the period from
August 12, 1949, to July 21, 1950,
inclusive 57.66
