"WHEREAS, after careful consideration and study, the Committee on Finance of the Fifth Municipal Board, to which the proposed 1965-1966 Ormoc City Budget has been referred by the Honorable Body, is of the opinion that the estimate of the revenue and receipts of Ormoc City from all sources (General Fund) is practicable and correct;

"WHEREAS, this august Body would like to dispense with its item on transportation allowance for the Vice-Mayor and Presiding Officer and the eight members of the Municipal Board and would like, instead, to partially implement Republic Act 4477 for the said elective city officials in this third class chartered city of ours, including the Secretaries to the City Mayor and the Municipal Board, even as this Body desires to also partially implement Administrative Order No. 78, series of 1963, for city employees holding key positions in their respective departments, in the matter of standardization of salaries, so much so that substantial increases in compensation could be effected without prejudice to more public improvements which the City is in dire need of;

"WHEREAS, in the wake of the passage and approval of Republic Act 4180, otherwise known as the new Minimum Wage Law, this august Body is somehow constrained to raise, likewise, the salaries of employees now receiving the old minimum monthly rate of One Hundred Twenty Pesos (P120.00) to the new one of One Hundred Fifty Pesos (P150.00) considering that Ormoc City is still classified under a third class category, aside from the fact that other employees now actually receiving one hundred fifty pesos a month or more could also be given a raise of no less than thirty pesos a month and even more taking into consideration their length of service, eligibility, responsibility or nature of work or position, and the like;

"WHEREAS, for greater efficiency in some departments this august Body has acceded to the request of their heads for creation of some new positions, viz:

1. Office of the City Mayor: One (1) Technical Assistant effective December 1, 1965. This is not really a new position but merely a reinstatement since was abolished two years ago over the veto of the City Mayor and which veto was sustained by Malacañang;

2. Finance Department: One (1) Auditing Aide effective January 1, 1966, to perform internal auditing works and other allied duties defined by the City Treasurer; and One (1) Driver-Mechanic effective January 1, 1966, commensurate with the purchase of one (1) jeep for official use of the department;

3. Police Department: Four (4) Patrolmen effective January 1, 1966. The Chief of Police in a letter dated December 8, 1965, has informed that with the present force of ninety (90) members, his department is undermanned to render maximum service. With the transfer of the police headquarters to the new government center and with the establishments of police precincts in barrios Ipil, Valencia and Curva, our city law-enforcing agency does not have enough members to maintain peace and order to the maximum within the city proper. It is astonishing to note that Ormoc City with eighty-three thousand (83,000) inhabitants, more or less, has only ninety (90) members of its police force or, relatively speaking, one patrolman for every nine hundred three (903) residents, more or less, to be served or at least protected which proportion is quite hazardous with rising tides of criminalities that may occur every now and then. The Chief of Police is requesting for at least ten (10) new positions of patrolmen but this august Body would like to consider only four (4) for the present with the hope that it could at least help the department a little in its service to the general public taking into account budgetary limitations; and

4. Ormoc City High School: Fifteen (15) Provisional Teachers who are now actually teaching to cope with the ever-growing school population; One (1) Clerk-Typist to do clerical activities for the voluminous reports, records, communication, and the like; One (1) Janitor-Watchman, a very indispensable position; and Three (3) Student-Janitors in addition to the five existing positions for the upkeep of the school buildings and grounds.

"WHEREAS, the proposed budget for the fiscal year 1965-1966 as submitted to the Fifth Municipal Board is a balanced budget;

"NOW, THEREFORE, the Board, on motion of Councilor Abas, seconded by Councilors Alfaro and Kierulf and the Floor Leader;

"RESOLVED, to adopt:

ORDINANCE NO. 74

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF ONE MILLION TWO HUNDRED NINETY-ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED SEVENTY-THREE PESOS AND FORTY-THREE CENTAVOS (₱1,291,873.43) TO BE MADE AVAILABLE FOR THE NECESSARY EXPENSES OF THE VARIOUS DEPARTMENTS AND/OR OFFICES OF THE GOVERNMENT OF ORMOC CITY, PHILIPPINES, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR FROM JULY 1, 1965, TO JUNE 30, 1966.

BE IT ORDAINED, by authority of the Municipal Board of Ormoc City, Philippines, pursuant to the provisions of Republic Act 179, as amended by Republic Act 429, otherwise known as the Charter of Ormoc City, That:

SECTION 1. The sum of ONE MILLION TWO HUNDRED NINETY-ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED SEVENTY-THREE PESOS AND FORTY-THREE CENTAVOS (₱1,291,873.43), or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of the unappropriated fund existing in the City Treasury to be made available for the necessary expenses of the following various departments and/or offices of the Government of Ormoc City, Philippines, for the fiscal year from July 1, 1965, to June 30, 1966, to wit:





SECTION 2. All sums appropriated in this Ordinance for salaries and wages for the various departments and/or offices of the City Government shall be expended for the specific purposes for which they are appropriated and no amount appropriated for salaries and wages shall be made available for the payment of contingent and other expenses or vice versa: PROVIDED, HOWEVER, That by resolution of the Municipal Board upon approval of the City Mayor, the City Treasurer shall enter in the account books of the City such transfer or readjustment of unexpended balances from one item to another in this appropriation ordinance for the purpose of paying obligations which are expressly authorized by law.

SECTION 3. The total amount appropriated in this Ordinance for the contingent expenses of any department and/or office of the City Government shall be made available for the specific authority of the Board to be done by resolutions duly approved by the City Mayor for the payment of any or all items or contingent expenses pertinent to the said department and/or office: PROVIDED, HOWEVER, That the respective appropriations herein made for the said department and/or office for traveling expenses of personnel shall be made available for payment of such expenses as may accrue to the said department and/or office by reason of the operation of the Revised Administrative Code.




