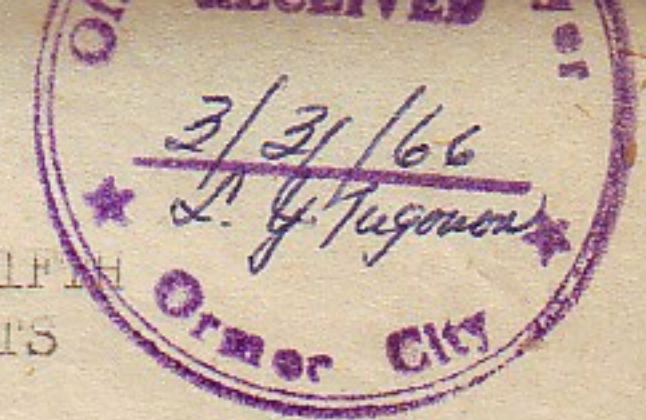

ORDINANCE NO. 14

AN ORDINANCE REVERTING THE SUM OF ₱1,500.00 FROM ITEMS NO. 17 AND NO. 18, (C-6) ASSESSMENT DEPARTMENT, PAGE 9, 1965-1966 ORMOC CITY BUDGET, FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF ITS ANNEX OFFICE AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

BE IT ORDAINED by the Municipal Board of Ormoc City, Philippines, That:

SECTION 1. The sum of ₱1,500.00, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby reverted from Item No. 17 (Revision of Assessment and Purchase of Materials) and Item No. 18 (Traveling Expenses of Deputy Assessors) under (C-6) Assessment Department, Page 9, 1965-1966 Ormoc City Budget, to be made available for the construction of an annex office of the Assessment Department behind the City Hall to solve the congestion problem of the department.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval.
