ORDINANCE NO. 17

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR SALARY ADJUSTMENT OF THE ASSISTANT CHIEF OF POLICE FROM ₱3,600 to ₱6,000 EFFECTIVE AS OF JAN-UARY 1, 1966, IN CONSONANCE WITH REPUBLIC ACT 4477 FOR BHIRD-CLASS CHARTERED CITY, AND INCORPORATING THIS ITEM ORDINANCE NO. 15 DATED APRIL 6, 1966.
