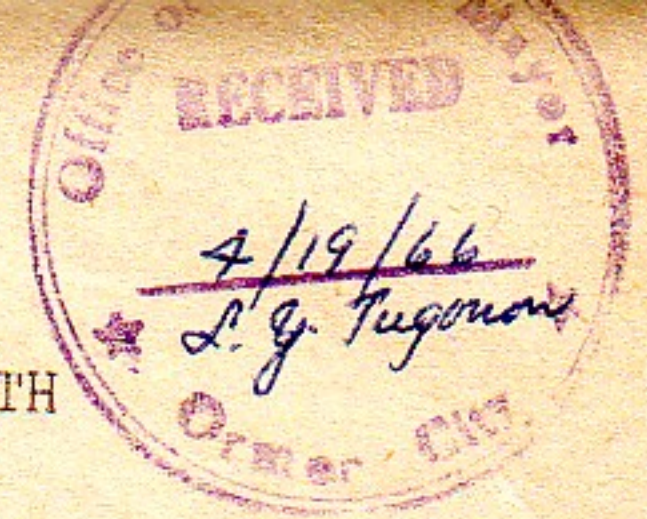

"RESOLVED, to adopt:

ORDINANCE NO. 17

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR SALARY ADJUSTMENT OF THE ASSISTANT CHIEF OF POLICE FROM ₱3,600 to ₱6,000 EFFECTIVE AS OF JANUARY 1, 1966, IN CONSONANCE WITH REPUBLIC ACT 4477 FOR THIRD-CLASS CHARTERED CITY, AND INCORPORATING THIS ITEM ORDINANCE NO. 15 DATED APRIL 6, 1966.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Municipal Board of Ormoc City, Philippines, That:


SECTION 1. The salary adjustment of the Assistant Chief of Police is hereby incorporated to Ordinance No. 15 dated April 6, 1966, from ₱3,600 to ₱6,000 per annum effective as of January 1, 1966, in consonance with Republic Act No. 4477 and in line with the category of Ormoc City as a Third-Class Chartered City;

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval.



"CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY."




