RESOLUTION NO. 9

"The Board, on motion of Councilor Abas, seconded by Councilor Kierulf;

"RESOLVED, to adopt:

ORDINANCE NO. 3

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING THE AMOUNT OF ₱5,250.00 TO BE MADE AVAILABLE FOR SALARIES OF SEVEN NEW POSITION ITEMS OF PATROLMEN IN THE POLICE DEPARTMENT TO SUPPLEMENT THE PROVISIONS MADE FOR THIS PURPOSE UNDER BUDGET ORDINANCE NO. 74, SERIES OF 1965, CONSISTENT WITH ACTUAL REQUIREMENTS.

BE IT ORDAINED, by authority of the Municipal Board of Ormoc City, Philippines, pursuant to the provisions of Republic Act 179, as amended, otherwise known as the Charter of Ormoc City, That:

SECTION 1. The sum of Five Thousand Two Hundred Fifty Pesos (₱5,250), or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of unappropriated funds existing in the City Treasury to be made available as supplemental appropriation for the creation of seven (7) new position items of patrolmen in the Ormoc City Police Department with compensation at the rate of ₱1,800.00 per annum each effective February 1, 1966.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval.

ENACTED, January 10, 1966.
