ORDINANCE NO. 33

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$\frac{1}{2}75,000 TO BE MADE AVAILABLE FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A TAXPAYERS HALL AT THE GOVERNMENT CENTER SITE IN COGON COMBADO, ORMOC CITY, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

BE IT ORDAINED by the Municipal Board of Ormoc City, Philippines, That:

SECTION 1. The sum of \$\P75,000\$, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of funds existing in the city treasury not otherwise appropriated to be made available for the construction of the proposed TAXPAYERS! HALL at the Government Center Site, Cogon Combado, Ormoc City.

SECTION 2. This item shall be incorporated in the 1966-1967 Ormoc City Budget (supplemental) under Capital Outlays.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval.
