RESOLUTION NO. 193

"WHEREAS, due to limited funds and lack of firearms the Police Department was able to loan only a few pistols to the Municipal Board which are now in the possession of the Honorable Vice-Mayor and Presiding Officer and some members of this august Body;

"WHEREAS, the Board is contemplating to purchase more firearms for use in the Police Department and the Municipal Board itself considering that there are still some policemen and City Councilors who have no firearms and as such law enforcers and city officials, respectively, they ought to be armed not only for the personalities they bear as such agents of persons in authority but also for the protection of their lives and properties while serving the people for the latter's general well-being;

"NOW, THEREFORE, the Board, on motion of Councilor Abas, seconded by Councilor Du;

"RESOLVED, to adopt:

ORDINANCE NO. 35

AN ORDINANCE REVERTING THE SUM OF FOUR THOUSAND PESOS (\$4,000)
FROM OUT SALARY SAVINGS ACCRUING TO ANY AND ALL DEPARTMENTS
AND OFFICES OF THE CITY GOVERNMENT FOR THE PURCHASE OF TWENTY (20) PISTOLS WITH AMMUNITION FROM CAMP CRAME, QUEZON CITY,
FOR USE OF THE POLICE DEPARTMENT AND THE MUNICIPAL BOARD.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Municipal Board of Ormoc City, Philippines,

SECTION 1. The sum of Four Thousand Pesos (\$\frac{1}{2}4,000), or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby reverted from out of salary savings accruing to any and all departments or offices of the City Government said sum to be made available for appropriation for the purchase of twenty (20) pistols with ammunition from Camp Crame, Quezen City, for use of the Police Department and the Municipal Board.

SECTION 2. The pistols now in the possession of the Vice-Mayor and Presiding Officer and some Members of the Municipal Board loaned from the Police Department shall continue to be possessed by the said city officials: PROVIDED, HOWEVER, That the other Members of the Board who have not as yet been loaned the same shall be provided with said firearms thus purchased from Camp Crame, Quezon City, immediately as soon as they are available: PROVIDED, FURTHER, That the possession of these firearms and ammunition by the city officials concerned shall be subject to the action of the Chief of the Firearms Section, PC, Camp Crame, Quezon City.

10-25-66 All 10-25-66 SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval.

ENACTED, October 19, 1966.

"RESOLVED, FINALLY, to furnish a copy of this resolution-ordinance each to the Chief of the Philippine Constabulary and the Chief of the Firearms Section, both of Camp Crame, Quezon City; the Officer In Charge, the Chief of Police, and the Commanding Officer of Camp Downes, all of Ormoc City, for their information and guidance;
