RESOLUTION NO. 89

"The Board, on motion of Councilor Kierulf, seconded by all the other Councilors;

"RESOLVED, to adopt:

ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING INCOMING VESSELS TO SUBMIT FOR REGULAR SANITATION INSECTION AT THE PORT OF CRMOC CITY, PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Municipal Board of Ormoc City, That:

SECTION 1. All sea-going vessels dropping anchor and/or docking at the port of Ormoc City shall submit themselves for regular sanitation inspection to local health authorities.

SECTION 2. All masters of vessels or their authorized representatives shall at all times be ready to show their Bureau of Quarantine Form 118 and/or Sanitation Clearance Certificate from the port of origin indicating that they were duly inspected and cleared by the Bureau of Quarantine.

SECTION 3. The physical condition of the vessel or any part thereof should be clean and sanitary as soon as it docks at the port of Ormoc City.

SECTION 4. Personnel of the steward section of the bessel shall nave medical certificates as required in Section 12 of the Sanitary Regulation for Interisland Vessels promulgated by the Director of Quarantine.

SECTION 5. No person shall dump rubbish or garbage overboard while the vessel is in the harbor of Ormoc City.

SECTION 6. Any violation of any provision or provisions of this Ordinance shall be punishable by a fine of not less than ten pesos (P10.00) but not exceeding two hundred pesos (P200.00) or an imprisomment of not less than ten (10) days but not exceeding six (6) months, or both such fine and imprisonment at the discretion of the court.

SECTION 7. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval.
