RESOLUTION NO. 50

"WHEREAS, the Waterworks Supervisor in response to Resolution No. 24, current series, of this august Body, has requested an appropriation of P170.00 to cover the expenses in changing the pipe line to the city slaughterhouse in Alegria with a bigger one in order to provide said slaughterhouse with sufficient supply of water;

"NOW, THEREFORE, on motion of Councilor Aviles, seconded by Councilor Navarro;

"RESOLVED, to adopt:

ORDINANCE NO. 13

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING P170 FOR THE PURCHASE OF BIGGER
PIPES IN REPLACEMENT OF THE OLD PIPELINE TO THE CITY
SLAUGHTERHOUSE

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Municipal Board of Ormoc City, That:

SECTION 1. The sum of One Hundred Seventy Pesos (P170.00), or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of funds not otherwise appropriated in the city treasury to be made available as supplemental appropriation for the purchase of bigger pipes in replacement of the old pipe line to the City slaughterhouse.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval.
