ORDINANCE NO. 14

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING, FURTHER, SECTION 1 of ORDINANCE NO. 1, SERIES OF 1967, BY DELETING ITEM NO. 2 UNDER (C-6) ASSESSMENT DEPARTMENT

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Municipal Board of Ormoc City, That:

SECTION 1. Section 1 of Ordinance No. 1, series of 1967, is hereby amended, further, by deleting Item No. 2 under (C-6) Assessment Department thereof, more particularly, the position of Chief Deputy Assessor for reasons of economy.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval.
