BE IT ORDAINED, by the Municipal Board of Ormoc City, That:

SECTION 1. Title of the Ordinance. - The title of Ordinance No. 7, as amended by Ordinance No. 24, both series of 1964, is hereby amended, further, to read as follows:

> "AN ORDINANCE IMPOSING A STORAGE TAX OF TWO PESOS AND FIFTY CENTAVOS (\$2.50) FOR EVERY TON OF HEMP, MAGUEY, AND THE LIKE AND THIRTY CENTAVOS (PO.30) FOR EVERY SACK OF COPRA PURCHASED, SOLD, STORED, SHIPPED OR KEPT IN THE CITY OF ORMOC AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

SECTION 2. Section 1 of Ordinance No. 7, as amended by Ordinance No. 24, both series of 1964, is hereby amended, further, to ead as follows:

"SECTION 1. City tax. - Any person, partnership, firm, association or corporation duly licensed or engaged in buying and/or selling copra, hemp, maguey, and the like, who shall hold, keep or store the same at his place of business, bodega or elsewhere within the jurisdiction of the City of Ormoc, shall pay to the City Treasurer a storage tax of Two Pesos and Fifty Centavos (\$2.50) for every ton of hemp, maguey, and the like, and Thirty Centavos (\$0.30) for every sack of copra purchased, sold, stored, shipped or kept by any person or entity subject to this ordinance."

SECTION.3. This Ordinance shall take effect on the first day of the month immediately following the month of approval.
