RESOLUTION NO. 67

"WHEREAS, Miss Cleopatra C. Babiano, Social Worker-In Charge of the Social Welfare Administration, this City, has made strong representations by communication and in person with an urgent request for telephone service in her office situated at No. 163 Rizal Street, Ormoc City, due to the numerous contacts that she makes every day with other agencies of the Government and private entities in connection with the duties and responsibilities adherent to her office;

"WHEREAS, this august Body finds the request of Miss Babiano well grounded taking into account the multifarious assistance the Social Welfare Administration has been extending not only to the poor and the needy but also to various victims of fires, typhoons and other calamities that befall the City of Ormoc;

"NOW, THEREFORE, on motion of Councilor Samson, seconded by Councilor Tan;

"RESOLVED, to approve the request of the Social Worker-In Charge of the Social Welfare Administration, Ormoc City, and do, as this Body hereby does, adopt:

ORDINANCE NO. 22

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF SIXTY PESOS (P60.00) TO BE MADE AVAILABLE FOR AID TO THE SOCIAL WELFARE ADMINISTRATION FOR TELEPHONE SERVICE IN ITS OFFICE AT RIZAL STREET, ORMOC CITY, FROM MARCH TO JUNE, 1968

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Municipal Board of Ormoc City, That:

SECTION 1. The sum of Sixty Pesos (P60.00), or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of funds not otherwise appropriated in the City Treasury to be made available as supplemental appropriation for aid to the Social Welfare Administration for telephone service in its office at No. 163 Rizal Street, Ormoc City, for the period from March 1 to June 30, 1968, inclusive: Provided, however, that fund for the same purpose shall be provided for in subsequent general appropriation ordinances.

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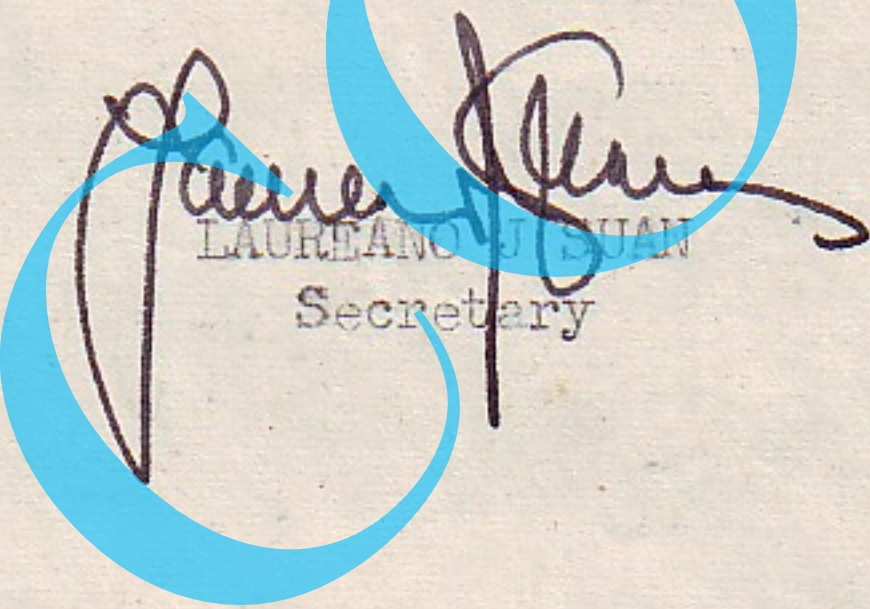
SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall take effect on March 1, 1968.

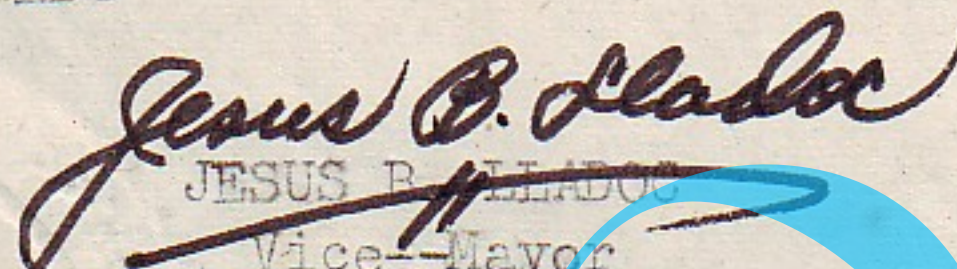

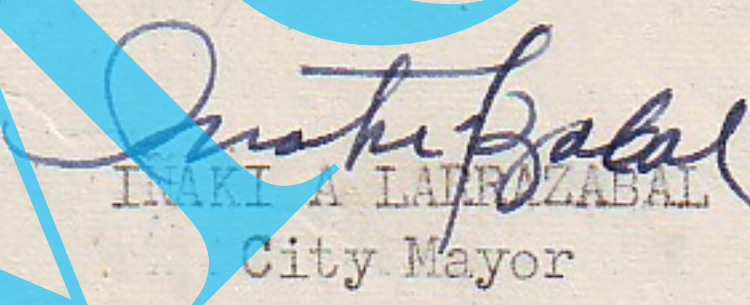

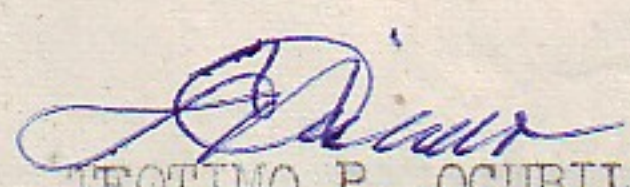
