

RESOLUTION NO. 74

"WHEREAS, the Acting Chief of Police has forwarded to this august Body the claim for reimbursement of actual and necessary traveling expenses incurred by Patrolman Maximo H. Lauron while on official business to effect the arrest of one Bonifacio Judilla, accused in Criminal Case No. 9170 for slight physical injuries, to Mandaw5, Cebu, and to follow up appointments and other papers in the Civil Service Commission, Cebu City, with a request for an approval of said claim;

"WHEREAS, after due examination of the papers pertinent to the travel and transportation of Patrolman Lauron, this august Body has found the same to be in order; amounting to P85.05;

"NOW, THEREFORE, on motion of Councilor Kangleon, seconded by Councilor Navarro;

"RESOLVED, to approve the request of the Acting Chief of Police and do, as this Body hereby does, adopt:

ORDINANCE NO. 23

AN ORDINANCE REVERTING AND/OR APPROPRIATING P85.05 FOR REIMBURSEMENT OF ACTUAL AND NECESSARY TRAVEL AND TRANSPORTATION EXPENSES OF PATROIMAN MAXIMO H. LAURON, OCPD

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Municipal Board of Ormoc City, That:

SECTION 1. The sum of Eighty-Five Pesos and Five Centavos (P85.05), or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated and/or reverted from savings accruing to the Police Department or from any funds in the City Treasury not otherwise appropriated to be made available as supplemental appropriation for the reimbursement of actual and necessary travel and transportation of Pat. Maximo H. Lauron to Mandawe, Cebu, and Cebu City on official business.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval.
