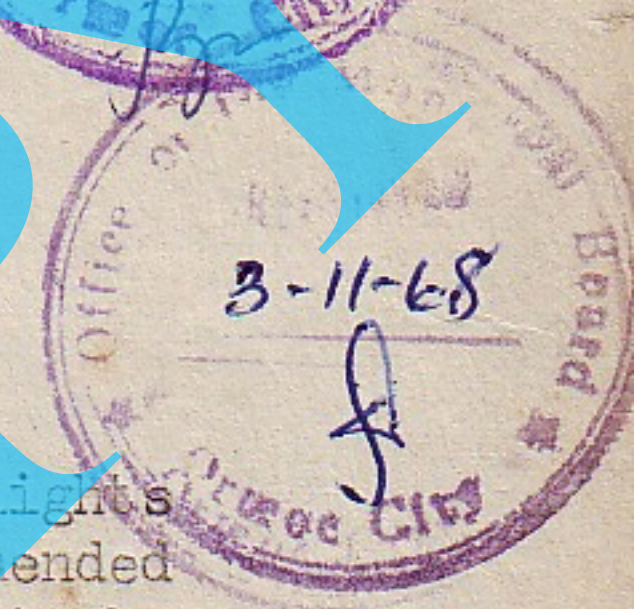

**RESOLUTION NO. 76**

"WHEREAS, there is an imperative necessity to improve the lights within the fish and meat sections of the public market as recommended by the Honorable Chairman of the Committee on Markets and Slaughterhouses, Councilor Cesar Samson;

"NOW, THEREFORE, on motion of Councilor Samson, seconded by the Floor Leader;

"RESOLVED, to adopt:

**ORDINANCE NO. 25**

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING ₱70.00 FOR THE PURCHASE OF FOUR MERCURY BULBS FOR INSTALLATION WITHIN THE FISH AND MEAT SECTIONS OF THE PUBLIC MARKET FOR BETTER LIGHTING AND OTHER PURPOSES

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Municipal Board of Ormoc City, That:

SECTION 1. The sum of Seventy Pesos (₱70.00), or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of funds not otherwise appropriated in the City Treasury to be made available as supplemental appropriation for the purchase of four (4) mercury bulbs for installation within the fish and meat sections of the public market for better lighting and other purposes.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval.
