## RESOLUTION NO. 113

ORDINANCE NO. 33

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Municipal Board of Ormoc City, That:

SECTION 1. The sum of One Hundred Thirty-Seven Pesos (\$137.00), or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of funds not otherwise appropriated in the city treasury to be made available as supplemental appropriation for the travel and transportation of Pat. Rosito Alcordo of Tagum, Davao del Norte, to Ormoc City to appear before the Office of the City Fiscal as Government witness in a homicide case against Mateo Pepito et al.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval.
