

ITS SESSION HALL ON MAY 22, 1968



RESOLUTION NO. 160

"WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Honorable City Mayor to equip the Ormoc City Police Department with the standard uniform, insignias and individual and operational equipment as early as possible or before the coming city festival considering that the present police paraphernalia are already obsolete they being not in accordance with the ones prescribed by Rule XI of the Police Manual; and

"WHEREAS, it is the obligation of the city to provide its police force with such uniform, insignias and individual and operational equipment pursuant to Section 6 of Republic Act No. 4864, otherwise known as the Police Act of 1965;

"NOW, THEREFORE, on motion of Councilor Kangleon, seconded by the Floor Leader;

"RESOLVED, to adopt:

ORDINANCE NO. 47

AN ORDINANCE REVERTING P6,000.00 FROM SALARY SAVINGS OF THE POLICE DEPARTMENT AS SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION FOR THE PURCHASE OF THE NECESSARY STANDARD UNIFORM, INSIGNIAS AND INDIVIDUAL AND OPERATIONAL EQUIPMENT OF THE ORMOC CITY POLICE DEPARTMENT.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Municipal Board of Ormoc City, That:

SECTION 1. The sum of six thousand pesos (P6,000.00), or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby reverted from salary savings of the Ormoc City Police Department to be made available as supplemental appropriation for the purchase of the necessary standard uniform, insignias and individual and operational equipment of the said department.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval.

ENACTED, May 22, 1968.

"RESOLVED, FURTHER, to furnish a copy of this resolution each to the Chief of Police, the City Treasurer and the City Auditor, all of Ormoc City;
