RESOLUTION NO. 163

"WHEREAS, the Development Officer of the local Presidential Arm on Community Development (PACD) has made representations with this august Body, through the Honorable Chairman of the Committee on Public Works, Councilor Jose C. Aviles, asking for a new light installation in his office because his lights have been cut by the Ormoc Electric Company for lack of appropriation;

"WHEREAS, this august Body finds the necessity for lights of the office of the local PACD considering that said entity is very busy day in and day out;

"NOW, THEREFORE, on motion of Councilor Aviles, seconded by the Floor Leader;

"RESOLVED, to adopt:

ORDINANCE NO. 49

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING P120.00 PER ANNUM FROM THE CITY COUNTER-PART FUND FOR PACD PROJECTS TO FINANCE THE LIGHT CONSUMPTION OF THE LOCAL PRESIDENTIAL ARM ON COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT (PACD)

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Municipal Board of Ormoc City, That:

SECTION 1. The sum of one hundred twenty pesos (P120.00), or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of the City Counterpart Fund for PACD Projects to be made available for payment of electric light consumption of the local Presidential Arm on Community Development (PACD): Provided, that this same item shall be incorporated in subsequent general appropriations.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval.
