



"WHEREAS, records in the police blotter have shown numerous violations of the one-way traffic rules and regulations along streets declared as one way, temporary or permanent, in Ormoc City;

"WHEREAS, no amount of apprehensions will deter the malpractice of these incompetent drivers of motor vehicles, rigs and the like, including cyclists, who deliberately disregard one-way traffic signs to the consternation of others who religiously follow one-way traffic rules and regulations to avoid road mishaps;

"WHEREAS, one way of curbing this bad habit of contemptible drivers and cyclists is to impose penalties for violations of one-way traffic rules and regulations;

"NOW, THEREFORE, on motion of Councilor Porcadilla, seconded by Councilor Kangleon;

"RESOLVED, to adopt:

ORDINANCE NO. 50

AN ORDINANCE PENALIZING DRIVERS AND/OR CYCLISTS FOR VIOLATIONS OF ONE-WAY TRAFFIC RULES AND REGULATIONS IN THE CITY OF ORMOC

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Municipal Board of Ormoc City, That:

SECTION 1. There shall be imposed penalties on drivers of any motor vehicle, rig and the like, and/or cyclists for violations of one-way traffic rules and regulations on streets declared as one way now or later, temporary or permanent, in the City of Ormoc, as follows:

- a) For the first offense, a reprimand;
- b) For the second offense, a fine of not less than five pesos (₱5.00);
- c) For the third and every subsequent offense thereafter, a fine of not less than ten pesos (\$10.00) but not more than fifty pesos (\$50.00).

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval.

ENACTED, May 29, 1968.

"RESOLVED, FURTHER, to furnish a copy of this resolution-ordinance each to the Honorable City Judge, the City Fiscal, the Chief of Police, the City Engineer, the City Auditor, the City Treasurer, and all drivers of motor vehicles and rigs, including cyclists, all of Ormoc City;
