

"RESOLVED, to adopt:

ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 1 OF ORDINANCE NO. 37, SERIES OF 1968, ENTITIED VAN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND REVISING ALL ORDINANCES RELATIVE TO FIXING AND REGULATING OF WHARF OR PIER CHARGES IN THE USE OF PORT FACILITIES OF ORMCC CITY.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Municipal Board of Ormoc City, That:

SECTION 1. Section 1 of Ordinance No. 37, series of 1968, entitled 'An Ordinance Amending and Revising All Ordinances Relative to Fixing and Regulating of Wharf or Pier Charges in the Use of Port Facilities of Ormoc City, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"SECTION 1. Harbor, berthing, wharfage or anchorage fee. - Every vessel propelled by steam or internal combustion engine and engaged in the Philippine coastwise trade, excepting pleasure or non-commercial craft, which berths at a pier, wharf, bulkhead-wharf, river or channel marginal wharf, or which sheds or makes fast to any vessel lying at such wharf or pier, anchors or moors at the Port of Ormoc City for the purpose of loading or discharging cargo or for any other purpose except when in distress, shall pay a harbor, berthing, wharfage or anchorage fee, as the case may be, as follows:

- (a) Vessels of less than 100 gross tons shall pay a berthing fee each of One Peso (#1.00) for the first twenty-four (24) hours or part thereof and Fifty Centavos (#0,50) for . each succeeding twenty-four (24) hours or part thereof; and
- (b) Vessels of 100 gross tons and above shall pay a berthing fee of One-Half Centavo (\$0.005) per gross ton for the first twenty-four (24) hours or part thereof and One-Fourth Centavo (FO.0025) per gross ton for each succeeding twentyfour (24) hours or part thereof, but in no case shall the minimum charge be less than Two Pesos (\$2.00) for the first day and One Peso (1.00) for each succeeding day or part thereof:



PROVIDED, That masted vessels shall pay berthing or anchorage fees as follows:

One-mast vessel, Two Pesos (F2.00) for the first twentyfour (24) hours or fraction thereof and One Peso (F1.00) for each succeeding twenty-four (24) hours or fraction thereof;

Two-mast vessel, Three Pesos (\$\P\$3.00) for the first twenty-four (24) hours or fraction thereof and One Peso and Fifty Centavos (\$\P\$1.50) for each succeeding twenty-four (24) hours or fraction thereof;

Three-mast vessel, Five Pesos (\$\overline{F}_5.00) for the first twenty-four (24) hours or fraction thereof and Two Pesos and Fifty Centavos (\$\overline{F}_2.50) for each succeeding twenty-four (24) hours or fraction thereof:

PROVIDED, FURTHER, that pump boats shall pay each Fifty Centavos (FO.50) per docking; and PROVIDED, FINALLY, That cargoes stored or uncollected in the pier shall be subject to wharfage fees of Two Pesos (F2.00) for the first twenty-four (24) hours or fraction thereof and One Peso (F1.00) for each succeeding twenty-four (24) hours or fraction thereof.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval.
