

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RESOLUTION NO. 22

"WHEREAS, in order to update the ordinance on slaughter and market fees, the Honorable Committee on Ways and Means and the Committee on Markets and Slaughterhouses concurrently chaired by Councilor Cesar Samson have conducted a series of public hearings attended by almost all stallholders or store owners and vendors of all sorts in the public market including, among others, the butchers;

"WHEREAS, after a painstaking study of the two committees and the conferees abovementioned, the latter have agreed a raise of the market and slaughter fees by twenty-five percentum of the old rates of the 1948 vintage considering that the present Administration is bent on carrying out its program of improvements in the public market and slaughterhouse in particular and the City of Ormoc in general;

"NOW, THEREFORE, on motion of Councilor Samson, seconded by the Floor Leader;

"RESOLVED, to adopt:

ORDINANCE NO. 6

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS 1 AND 2 OF ORDINANCE NO. 16,
SERIES OF 1948, ENTITLED, "AN ORDINANCE IMPOSING MARKET
AND SLAUGHTER FEES UPON PERSONS, COMPANIES, FIRMS OR
CORPORATIONS ENGAGED IN VARIOUS BUSINESSES WITHIN THE
PUBLIC MARKET BUILDINGS AND THEIR PREMISES, PROVIDING
PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Municipal Board of Ormoc City, That:

SECTION 1. Amendment. - Section 1 of Ordinance No. 16, series of 1948, entitled, "An Ordinance Imposing Market and Slaughter Fees upon Persons, Companies, Firms or Corporations Engaged in Various Businesses within the Public Market Buildings and their Premises, providing Penalties for Violations Thereof, and for Other Purposes," is hereby amended to read as follows:

"SECTION 1. Market Vendor. - There shall be levied and collected from each and every person, company, firm or corporation engaged in any business within the public market buildings and their premises, the following market and slaughter fees:

B-1 - Dealer in salted or dried fish19	per sq. meter
B-2 - Sari-sari, dry goods, or liquor dealer19	" "
B-3 - Vendor of fresh meat63	" "
B-4 - Paintit19	" "
B-5 - Vendor of vegetables13	" "
B-6 - Retail tuba dealer13	" "

B-7 - Retail leaf tobacco dealer	₱0.19 per sq. meter
B-8 - Vendor of rice, palay or corn25 " " "
(B-9 - deleted)
B-10 - Vendor of chickens75 per dozen
B-11 - Wholesale dealer of salted bolinao, hipon, sisi, lobod, or maobgas19 per petroleum can
B-12 - Wholesale dealer of bodo or tabagak63 per tabig
B-13 - Wholesale dealer of dried bolinao, libod or quiampi25 per sack
B-14 - Wholesale dealer of any other dried or salted fish not included above13 per sack
B-15 - Vendor of crabs or other similar sea products13 per day
B-16 - Vendor of embao or similar product13 " "
B-17 - Vendor of any other sea shells06 " "
B-18 - Vendor of cooked bananas, corn, camote or casava13 " "
B-19 - Vendor of bananas13 " "
B-20 - Vendor of camote or casava13 per petroleum can
B-21 - Carenderia, sari-sari store, or other establishment paying monthly rentals of lot in the public market25 per day"

SECTION 2. Amendment. - Section 2 of Ordinance No. 16, series of 1948, entitled, "An Ordinance Imposing Market and Slaughter Fees upon Persons, Companies, Firms nor Corporations Engaged in Various Businesses within the Public Market Buildings and their Premises, providing Penalties for Violations Thereof, and for Other Purposes," is hereby amended to read as follows:

"SECTION 2. Fresh Fish. - For purposes of this Ordinance the different kinds of fishes sold in the public market are hereby classified and the corresponding market fees fixed, as follows:

First Class: Tanggui, jasa-an, mahinlo, tamarong, marapati, borao, bolis, mangsi, bancol, barilis, bolis, manangbo, cawayanon, ulisi, banak, aha-an, bahalo, pugapo, bat-og, tulingan, kitong, awa, katambak, saguisi-on, pangalwan, mambulao, laii, balinsaog, balo, nocos (squid fish) pasayan, bilong-bilong, or tamban, or fresh water eel (casili) or agok-ok, and other big fishes not mentioned in 2nd, 3rd and 4th classes ... ₱0.05 per kilo

Second Class: Bolinao, quiampi, langiri, pangan, tigi, or any kind of fresh water fish, except those fresh water fishes mentioned or designated as First Class

.04 per kilo

Third Class: Iho, pagui, lomod

.03 per kilo

Fourth Class: Any other fish not included in the above classification

.02 per kilo

Sea Turtle, large

1.25 each

Sea Turtle, small

.63 each


SECTION 3. Effectivity. - This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval.

ENACTED, January 17, 1968.




