

dwellings abound, in streets, plazas and other public places within the poblacion from seven o'clock in the evening (7:00 P.M.) until five o'clock in the morning (5:00 A.M.). Blowing of horns for the purpose of calling for passengers is strictly prohibited in the places aforementioned within the city proper at any time of the day.

"Any violation of this particular rule shall be punishable by a fine of not less than ten pesos (P10.00) or not more than fifty pesos (P50.00)."


SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval.




