RESOLUTION NO. 14

"The Board, on motion of Councilor Porcadilla, seconded by the
Floor Leader;

"RESOLVED, to adopt:

ORDINANCE NO. 5

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE SALE, DISPLAY OR STORAGE OF
PETROLEUM, OIL, ALCOHOL, GASOLINE OR THE LIKE IN THE
CITY OF ORMOC AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS
THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Municipal Board of Ormoc City, That:

SECTION 1. Regulations. - The sale, display or storage of pet-
roleum, oil, alcohol, gasoline or the like, be it within the commer-
cial or residential districts of the city, is hereby made subject to
the following regulations:

a) A wholesaler can display his wares in his estab-
lishment provided that they shall not be in excess of
five (5) cans a day, otherwise, said excess shall be
kept or stored in underground storage or vaults approved
by the Chief of the Fire Department.

b) No wholesaler shall be allowed to retail his
wares by ounces, pints, liters, gallons or the like
which necessitate the opening of the displayed cans.

c) A retailer can sell and display at the same
time only one (1) can a day provided that the can
shall be kept close at all times and shall be opened
only as often as costumers may buy the ware.

SECTION 2. Penalty for violation. - Any violation of the pro-
visions of this Ordinance shall be punishable by an imprisonment
of not exceeding six (6) months or a fine of not exceeding five
hundred pesos (P500.00), or both such imprisonment and fine at
the discretion of the cort. In case of a company, corporation,
partnership or the like, the manager, president, or managing
partner, as the case may be, shall be held responsible.

SECTION 3. Repeal. - Any ordinance or provision thereof inconsistent with this Ordinance is hereby repealed.


SECTION 4. Effectivity. - This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval.






