RESOLUTION NO. 143

"WHEREAS, the City Auditor in a letter dated November 24, 1969, had requested necessary appropriations for the unauthorized positions of three (3) Police Sergeants and four (4) Police Corporals, as well as for the unauthorized rates of compensation of the ten (10) Patrolmen, all of the Ormoc City Police Department, which have been existing since July 1, 1968, and of which positions the persons concerned have collected their corresponding salaries based on the fact that their positions existed during the fiscal years 1966-1967 and 1967-1968 and that they are provided with their respective appointments;

"WHEREAS, the Honorable Chairman of the Committee on Police, Fire and Public Safety, Councilor Juanito T. Kangleon, reported that most of the members of the Ormoc City Police Department who qualified under Section 9 of Republic Act No. 4864 just received the attestations of their respective ranks and grades as their appropriate eligibilities from the Civil Service Commission which attestations were made effective long before our attention was called by the City Auditor;

"WHEREAS, Councilor Kangleon reported, further, that there are ten (10) Patrolmen receiving ₱2,160.00 each per annum but whose ranks were not raised to Patrolmen First Class as contemplated in Item No. 7 of (C-15) Police Department, page 11, 1969-1970 Ormoc City Budget, so that Councilor Kangleon recommended that Item No. 7 be amended to only ten (10) Patrolmen First Class so that the other ten (10) will be incorporated in a new item as Patrolmen with the same rate of compensation which they are actually receiving at present even as he recommended the reduction of Item No. 8 from fifty (50) to only thirty-eight (38) Patrolmen at the rate of ₱1,800.00 each per annum which they are presently receiving;

"WHEREAS, Councilor Kangleon also recommended that a new item for Police Major be incorporated with a compensation at the rate of ₱4,200.00 per annum, while Item No. 4 be reduced from two (2) to only one (1) Police Lieutenant, and to serve the purpose as requested by the City Auditor, Item No. 5 be augmented from five (5) to eight (8) Police Sergeants, and Item No. 6 be also augmented from ten (10) to fifteen (15) Police Corporals, both, with the same rates of compensation;

"WHEREAS, according to Councilor Kangleon, there are actually only seventy-seven (77) officers and men in the Police Department instead of ninety (90) as provided for in the 1969-1970 Ormoc City Budget so that even with the proposed amendments recommended by him, there will still be much salary savings accruing to the department, more so, because the Honorable City Mayor is not intending to increase the present force for the current fiscal year;

"NOW, THEREFORE, on motion of Councilor Kangleon, seconded by Councilor Aviles;

"RESOLVED, to adopt:

ORDINANCE NO. 50

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CERTAIN ITEMS UNDER THE HEADING OF SALARIES AND WAGES OF (C-15) POLICE DEPARTMENT, PAGE 11, 1969-1970 ORMOC CITY BUDGET, CREATING SOME NEW POSITIONS AND PROVIDING FUNDS FOR COMPENSATION THERE-OF, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Municipal Board of Ormoc City, That:

SECTION 1. The provision of (C-15) Police Department for salaries and wages, page 11, 1969-1970 Ormoc City Budget, are hereby amended to read as follows:
