RESOLUTION NO. 21

"WHEREAS, a group of lady teachers headed by Mrs. Fortunata Digman-Mantua composing the committee on ways and means for the forthcoming Eighth Division Girl Scouts Leaders' Conference has made representations with this august Body for the latter's contribution to the dinner-award which will be held in Ormoc City and attended by various delegations from Kananga to Natonin comprising the Division of Leyte III next Saturday, February 14, 1970;

"WHEREAS, the officers of the Rotary Club of Ormoc headed by Dr. Jaime D. Gatchalian, together with the officers of the Inner Wheel Club of Ormoc, also made representations with this august Body asking if it would not be too much for the City Government to tender a luncheon on April 25, 1970, during the regional convention of the Eastern Visayas Jaycee chapters in which the Ormoc Jaycee Chapter will be the host to the various chapters of Cebu, Mandawe, Lapulapu, Tagbilaran and Tacloban for two days, April 25-26, 1970;

"WHEREAS, after due consideration on the matters, this Honorable Board have decided to accede to the requests of both the committee on ways and means of the forthcoming Eighth Division Girl Scouts Leaders' Conference and the officers of the Rotary Club of Ormoc taking into account that the girl scouts movement is indeed a help to the government, much more so with the Rotary Club of Ormoc which has done valuable help and service to our constituents especially in the rural areas, citing in this instance a particular project which the Club has been carrying on for quite a time now, the Medicare Program;

"NOW, THEREFORE, on motion of Councilor Porcadilla, seconded by the Floor Leader;

"RESOLVED, to adopt:

ORDINANCE NO. 15

AN ORDINANCE REVERTING THE AGGREGATE SUM OF EIGHT HUNDRED PESOS (P800.00) FROM OUT THE ITEM ON DBP LOAN AMORTIZATION UNDER MARKET AND SLAUGHTERHOUSE, CURRENT APPROPRIATION, TO BE MADE AVAILABLE AS SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION FOR CONTRIBUTION TO THE DINNER-AWARD OF THE EIGHTH DIVISION GIRL SCOUTS LEADERS' CONFERENCE ON FEBRUARY 14, 1970, AND FOR LUNCHEON TO BE TENDERED BY THE CITY GOVERNMENT TO THE DELEGATES OF THE EASTERN VISAYAS JAYCEE REGIONAL CONVENTION ON APRIL 25, 1970.



BE IT ORDAINED, by the Municipal Board of Ormoc City, That:

SECTION 1. The aggregate sum of eight hundred pesos (P800.00, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby reverted from out of the item on DBP loan amortization under (C-36) Market and Slaughterhouse, current appropriation, said sum to be made available for purposes in the manner provided hereunder as follows:

- a) Contribution of the City Government to the dinner-award in connection with the Eighth Division Girl Scouts Leaders' Conference in Ormoc City on Feb. 14, 1970 ..... P200.00
- b) Luncheon to be tendered by the City Government to the delegates of the Eastern Visayas Jayce Regional Convention in Ormoc City on April 25, 1970 ..... 500.00
- Total ..... P800.00

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval.

"RESOLVED, FURTHER, to furnish a copy of this resolution-ordinance each to the City Treasurer, the City Auditor, the Committee on Ways and Means of the Eighth Division Girl Scouts Leaders' Conference, City Central School, and the President of the Rotary Club of Ormoc, all of Ormoc City;
