


SIXTH MUNICIPAL BOARD OF ORMOC CITY, PHILIPPINES, HELD
AT ITS SESSION HALL ON FEBRUARY 18, 1970

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RESOLUTION NO. 25

"WHEREAS, the Supervising Management Analyst I and In Charge, Office of the City Treasurer, this City, in a communication dated February 13, 1970, has informed this august Body that PC S/Sgt. Gregorio Marquez, father and claimant for death benefits of the late Pat. Felix C. Marquez of the Ormoc City Police Department, has presented to his office a voucher in the amount of ₱4,477.60 broken down as follows:

Death compensation	₱ 3,577.60	
Burial expenses	200.00	
Medical expenses	500.00	₱ 4,477.60

in compliance with the award of the Workmen's Compensation Unit, Tacloban City, dated January 10, 1969, in Case No. RO9-WCC-9453, Felix Marquez (deceased) and Gregorio Marquez, claimants, versus Ormoc City Government, respondent; a copy of which award has been furnished this august Body;

"WHEREAS, this claim of S/Sgt. Marquez has not been incorporated in our current budget as an outstanding obligation so that the same cannot be settled immediately;

"WHEREAS, this august Body had set a policy to pay claims of this nature on installment basis as in the cases of the late Chief of Police Ciriaco Porcadilla, Dr. Eutiquiano Fiel and Fiscal Ramon O. de Veyra;

"WHEREAS, there are sufficient savings in the Police Department with which to partially pay the aforementioned claim, say, at least one-third of the amount as first installment, with the remaining two-thirds to be obligated in subsequent general appropriation ordinances until the full amount shall be paid;

"NOW, THEREFORE, on motion of Councilor Kangleon, seconded by Councilor Samson;

"RESOLVED, to pay the claim for death benefits of the late Pat. Felix C. Marquez of the Ormoc City Police Department in three installments beginning with the current fiscal year and do, as this Body hereby does, adopt:

ORDINANCE NO. 17

AN ORDINANCE REVERTING THE SUM OF ONE THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED NINETY-TWO PESOS AND FIFTY-THREE CENTAVOS (P1,492.53), FROM OUT OF ANY SAVINGS IN THE POLICE DEPARTMENT TO BE MADE AVAILABLE FOR SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION TO COVER THE FIRST PAYMENT OF THREE INSTALLMENTS OF THE DEATH BENEFITS OF THE LATE PATROLMAN FELIX C. MARQUEZ OF THE SAME DEPARTMENT.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Municipal Board of Ormoc City, That:

SECTION 1. The sum of one thousand four hundred ninety-two pesos and fifty-three centavos (P1,492.53), or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby reverted from out of any savings in the Police Department, said sum to be made available for supplemental appropriation to cover the first payment of three annual installments of the death benefits of the late Patrolman Felix C. Marquez of the Ormoc City Police Department: PROVIDED, However, That the balance of P2,985.07 shall be provided for this purpose in subsequent general appropriation ordinances.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval.


ENACTED, February 18, 1970.


