"WHEREAS, our current appropriation for the city counterpart fund for maintenance of existing and unabandoned city roads, streets and bridges, including purchase of equipment and necessary supplies and materials in the sum of \$\mathbb{P}\$160,000.00 has already been exhausted so much so that it has become necessary to revert some unexpended balances and savings of the City for purposes of appropriation to cover the city counterpart of \$\mathbb{P}\$45,959.00 in order that the national counterpart will be released pertaining to the 1968-1969 fiscal year after the City Treasurer shall have certified to the availability of said city counterpart;

"NOW, THEREFORE, on motion of Councilor Kangleon, jointly seconded by Councilors Aviles and Samson;

"RESOLVED, to adopt:

AN ORDINANCE REVERTING THE SUM OF FORTY-FIVE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED FIFTY-NINE PESOS (\$\frac{1}{2}\$,959.00) FROM OUT OF UNEXPENDED BALANCES AND SAVINGS OF THE VARIOUS DEPARTMENTS AND/OR OFFICES OF THE CITY GOVERNMENT TO BE MADE AVAILABLE AS SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION FOR THE CITY'S COUNTERPART FOR THE STREET AND BRIDGE FUND PERTAINING TO THE 1968-1969 FIBCAL YEAR.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Municipal Board of Ormoc City That:

SECTION 1. The sum of Forty-Five Thousand Nine hundred Vifty-Nine Peses (P45,959.00), or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby reverted from out of unexpended balances and savings of the various departments and/or offices of the City Government, said sum to be made available as supplemental appropriation for the City's counterpart for the street and bridge fund pertaining to the fiscal year 1968-1969.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval.

"RESOLVED FURTHER, to direct the City Treasurer to immediately certify to the Honorable Commissioner of Public Highways, Manila, as to the availability of the city's counterpart for the street and bridge find in the sum of Forty Five Thousand Nine Hundred Fifty-Nine Pesca (P45,959.00); and

RESOLVAU, FINALLY to furnish a copy of this resolution-ordinance each to the Monorable Commissioner of Public Highways, Manila, and the Nity Tressurer, the City Auditor, and the City Engineer, all of Ormos City;
