CAUSED TO BE AUTHORIZED FOR RELEASE FOR OTHER  
PURPOSE THAN FOR MAINTENANCE OF JJ ROADS

"WHEREAS, our current appropriation for the city counterpart fund for maintenance of existing and unabandoned city roads, streets and bridges, including purchase of equipment and necessary supplies and materials in the sum of P160,000.00 has already been exhausted so much so that it has become necessary to revert some unexpended balances and savings of the City for purposes of appropriation to cover the city counterpart of P45,959.00 in order that the national counterpart will be released pertaining to the 1968-1969 fiscal year after the City Treasurer shall have certified to the availability of said city counterpart;

"NOW, THEREFORE, on motion of Councilor Kangleon, jointly seconded by Councilors Aviles and Samson;

ORDINANCE NO. 28

AN ORDINANCE REVERTING THE SUM OF FORTY-FIVE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED FIFTY-NINE PESOS (P45,959.00) FROM OUT OF UNEXPENDED BALANCES AND SAVINGS OF THE VARIOUS DEPARTMENTS AND/OR OFFICES OF THE CITY GOVERNMENT TO BE MADE AVAILABLE AS SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION FOR THE CITY'S COUNTERPART FOR THE STREET AND BRIDGE FUND PERTAINING TO THE 1968-1969 FISCAL YEAR.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Municipal Board of Ormoc City, That:

SECTION 1. The sum of Forty-Five Thousand Nine Hundred Fifty-Nine Pesos (P45,959.00), or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby reverted from out of unexpended balances and savings of the various departments and/or offices of the City Government, said sum to be made available as supplemental appropriation for the City's counterpart for the street and bridge fund pertaining to the fiscal year 1968-1969.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval.

ENACTED, April 1, 1970.

"RESOLVED, FURTHER, to direct the City Treasurer to immediately certify to the Honorable Commissioner of Public Highways, Manila, as to the availability of the city's counterpart for the street and bridge fund in the sum of Forty Five Thousand Nine Hundred Fifty-Nine Pesos (P45,959.00); and



"CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY."




