

RESOLUTION NO. 110


In view of the volume of patients and the tremendous amount of work confronting the City Health Office, the undersigned feels the need of another Medical Officer who could help render service to them. The barrio visits which used to be regular before has been interrupted every now and then. For this reason, this Office would request the conversion of the two items of midwives which has been long unfilled, to an item of a Medical Officer. Everyone in the office is unanimous to the opinion that a Medical Officer can do more for the community as to public service than two midwives, hence this request.

"WHEREAS, this Honorable Board finds the request of the City Health Officer worthy of our consideration taking into account the City of Ormoc with sixty barrios and a population of almost one hundred thousand:



"WHEREAS, much as we desire to retain the item of two midwives although unfilled in the City Health Department, nevertheless, exigency demands the preference for one more Medical Officer who, according to the consensus of the office personnel of said department, can do more for the community than two midwives in terms of public service;

"WHEREAS, the City Health Officer is recommending a compensation of \$\Pmu_1,800.00\$ per annum for a new Medical Officer so that if the appointment takes effect even today the amount necessary to last up to the end of the fiscal year will only be a little over \$\Pmu_1,000.00\$ which amount can be well covered by the reversion of the item of the two midwives in the current appropriation;

"NOW, THEREFORE, on motion of the Floor Leader, seconded by Councilor Torrevillas;

"RESOLVED, to approve the request of the City Health Officer and do, as this Body hereby does, adopt:

ORDINANCE NO. 55-A

AN ORDINANCE REVERTING THE ITEM OF TWO (2) CITY MIDWIVES IN THE CITY
HEALTH DEPARTMENT TO BE MADE AVAILABLE FOR THE CREATION OF THE
POSITION OF ONE (1) MEDICAL OFFICER WITH COMPENSATION AT THE
RATE OF FOUR THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED PESOS (\$\frac{1}{2}4,800.00) PER ANNUM.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Municipal Board of Ormoc City, That:

SECTION 1. Item No. 7 for two (2) City Midwives in the City Health Department is hereby reverted to a new position of Medical Officer with compensation at the rate of four thousand eight hundred pesos (P4,800) per annum: PROVIDED, That funds for this purpose shall be provided for in subsequent general appropriation ordinances.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval.

ENACTED, August 19, 1970.

RESOLUTION NO. 107

"WHEREAS, the Officer in Charge of the City Treasurer's Office in a communication dated August 11, 1970, has requested the reversion of ₱1,450,00 from out of salary savings of his department for the purchase of one revolver, Rimfire Magnum, Model 51, 3" barrel, cal. 22, inasmuch as he needs a weapon for his protection in the performance of his official duties being the custodian of government funds and properties;

"NOW, THEREFORE, on motion of Councilor Samson, seconded by Councilor Kangleon;

"RESOLVED, to approve the request of the Officer In Charge of the City Treasurer's Office and do, as this Body hereby does, adopt:

ORDINANCE NO. 55

AN ORDINANCE REVERTING THE SUM OF ONE THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED FIFTY PESOS (P1,450,00) FROM OUT OF SALARY SAVINGS IN THE FINANCE. DEPARTMENT TO BE MADE AVAILABLE AS SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIA-TION FOR THE PURCHASE OF ONE RIMFIRE MAGNUM REVOLVER, MODEL 51, 3" BARREL, CALIBER .22, FOR THE OFFICER IN CHARGE OF THE SAME DEPARTMENT.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Municipal Board of Ormoc City, That:

SECTION 1. The sum of one thousand four hundred fifty pesos (₱1,450), or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby reverted from out of salary savings in the Finance Department, said sum to be made available as supplemental appropriation for the purchase of one Rimfire Magnum revolver, model 51, 3" barrel, caliber .22, for the Officer In Charge of the same department.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval.
