"The Board, on motion of Councilor Porcadilla, seconded by Councilor Samson;

"RESOLVED, to adopt:

ORDINANCE NO. 68

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 3 OF ORDINANCE NO. 11, CURRENT SERIES, ENTITLED, "AN ORDINANCE TO LEVY MUNICIPAL, CAPITAL OR GROSS SALES TAXES OF ONE PER CENT (1%) ON THE SALE OF MERCHANDISE AND TWO PER CENT (2%) ON THE SALE OF HARDWARE AND AUTO SUPPLY IN THE CITY OF ORMOC AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Municipal Board of Ormoc City, That:

SECTION 1. Section 3 of Ordinance No. 11, series of 1970, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"SECTION 3. Penalty for violation. - Any violation of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be punishable by a fine of not less than fifty pesos (P50.00) but not exceeding two hundred pesos (P200.00) or an imprisonment of not less than one (1) month but not exceeding six (6) months, or both such fine and imprisonment at the discretion of the court. Repetition of the same offense for the third time shall subject the violator to a fine of not less than two hundred pesos (P200.00) and an imprisonment of not less than six (6) months.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval.
