RESOLUTION NO. 155

"The Board, on motion of the Floor Leader, seconded by Councilor Poreadilla;

"RESOLVED, to adopt:

ORDINANCE NO. 71

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE DISTRIBUTION AND/OR SALE OF DRUGS OR BIOLOGICAL PRODUCTS AND THE LIKE IN ORMOC CITY, PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Municipal Board of Ormoc City, That:

SECTION 1. Permit to distribute and/or sell drugs or biological products. - It shall be unlawful for any person or persons to distribute free of charge, peddle, hawk, and/or offer for sale any drug or biological product and the like in any public street, road or highway, park or plaza, or in any other public places within the territory of Ormoc City, except manufacturers and wholesale dealers of such drugs or biological products distributing free samples of the same to physicians, dentists, veterinarians, drug stores and medical and health centers, without first securing the necessary permit from the Office of the City Mayor through the recommendation of the City Health Officer. Except where otherwise provided, henceforth, no person shall distribute free of charge, throw away, deposit from door to door or leave upon private premises or public places any drug or biological product and the like in Ormoc City.

SECTION 2. Definition of terms. - For purposes of this Ordinance, the following terms are defined:

a) "Drug" - Any substance used as a medicine or in the treatment of disease.

b) "Biological product" - Any substance used in or produced by applied biology which may be in the form of vaccine, serum, antibiotic, vitamin, hormone, glandular extract or any such related preparations.



SECTION 3. Penalty for violation. - Any violation of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be punishable by a fine of not exceeding two hundred pesos (P200.00) or an imprisonment of not exceeding six (6) months, or both such fine and imprisonment at the discretion of the court. In case of a firm, company or corporation, the immediate supervisor shall be held responsible for the violation made by its personnel, otherwise, the president or manager of such firm, company or corporation shall be held liable.

SECTION 4. Separability. - Any ordinance or sections thereof inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby modified or repealed accordingly.

SECTION 5. Construction of this Ordinance. - If any part or section of this Ordinance shall be declared unconstitutional or ultra vires, the same shall not invalidate any other parts or sections hereof.

SECTION 6. Effectivity. - This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval.


