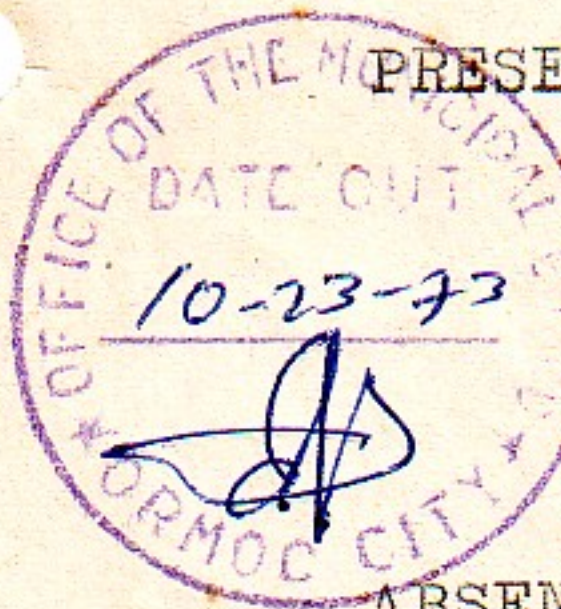

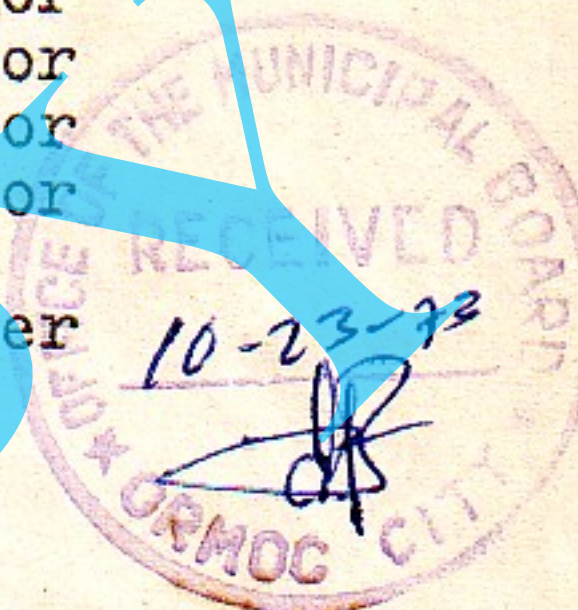

RESOLUTION NO. 161

"The Board, on motion of Councilor Mendola, seconded
by Councilor Tan;

"RESOLVED, to adopt:

ORDINANCE NO. 9

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING FURTHER ORDINANCE NO. 36, SERIES OF
1968, AS AMENDED BY ORDINANCE NO. 56, SERIES OF 1970,
OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE "PUBLIC CONVEYANCE ORDINANCE
OF ORMOC CITY", MORE PARTICULARLY, PARAGRAPH 4 OF
SECTION 5.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Municipal Board of Ormoc City,
That:

SECTION 1. Amendment. - Paragraph 4 of Section 5 of
Ordinance No. 36, series of 1968, as amended by Ordinance
No. 56, series of 1970, otherwise known as the "Public
Conveyance Ordinance of Ormoc City," is hereby amended
further to read as follows:

"SECTION 5. Rules and regulations covering
motorized tricycles. - x x x x x x x x x x x x x x x x"

"4. It shall be unlawful for any operator
or driver to collect a fare of more than fifteen
centavos (P0.15) for every adult passenger within
the city proper (poblacion): PROVIDED, That for
every such passenger whose destination is outside
the city proper, or vice versa, the operator or
his driver may collect such fare as may be reason-
able as:

- "a) Ormoc General Hospital, Cogon Combado,
Nadungholan, Punta, Alegria, Batuan,
or Can-adieng P0.20
- "b) Biliboy-Cogon junction, Bantigue,
Panalian, or Linao25
- "c) San Isidro, Ipil, or Nauñgan30
- "d) San Pablo, Macabug, or San Antonio35

PROVIDED, FURTHER, That from one barrio to another,
adjacent, the fare shall not be more than fifteen
centavos (P0.15), but from one barrio to another

passing through other barrios, the fare shall not be more than twenty-five centavos (₱0.25) regardless of the number of barrios traversed.

"It shall be the duty of the operator or his driver to print in bold letters and figures the rates of fare above prescribed on the windshield of every motorized tricycle unit for the information and guidance of passengers."


SECTION 2. Effectivity. - This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval.

ENACTED, October 18, 1973.



"CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY."




