RESOLUTION NO. 100

"The Board, on motion of Councilor Mendola, seconded
by Councilor Tan;

"RESOLVED, to adopt:

ORDINANCE NO. 10

AN ORDINANCE IMPOSING A FEE FOR THE USE OF THE
TUÑGONAN SWIMMING POOL, PROVIDING PENALTY
FOR VIOLATION THEREOF, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Municipal Board of Ormoc City,
That:

SECTION 1. Tuñgonan swimming pool fee. - There is here-
by levied for the use of the Tuñgonan swimming pool a fee in
accordance with the following schedule:

- a) Per person per day (except Sunday) ₱0.50
- b) Per person per Sunday 1.00

payable to the City Treasurer or his duly authorized deputy
who shall issue a corresponding receipt therefor in a form
of a cash ticket before a person uses the pool: Provided,
however, That any tourist or "balikbayan" shall be charged
only fifty percent of the regular fee.

SECTION 2. Definition of terms. - For purposes of this
Ordinance, the following terms are hereby defined:

a) "Balikbayan" - from the Tagalog phrase "balik sa
bayan" which means a Filipino resident or naturalized in
foreign states who returns to the Philippines for a visit.

b) Day - the period from sunrise to midnight.

c) Tourist - one who travels from place to place for
pleasure or culture.

d) Use - to swim in the pool.

SECTION 3. Penalty for violation. - Any violation of
the provisions of this Ordinance shall be punishable by a
fine of not more than fifty pesos or an imprisonment of
not more than five days, or both such fine and imprison-
ment at the discretion of the court.


SECTION 4. Effectivity. - This Ordinance shall take effect fifteen days after its approval by the Mayor.



"CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY."




