"RESOLVED, to adopt:

ORDINANCE NO. 12

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 3 of ORDINANCE
NO. 11, CURRENT SERIES, OTHERWISE KNOWN
AS THE "FISH-BY-THE-KILO SALE ORDINANCE"

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Municipal Board of Ormoc City,
That:

SECTION 1. Amendment. - Section 3 of Ordinance No.
11, current series, otherwise known as the "Fish-by-the-
Kilo Sale Ordinance", is hereby amended to read as fol-
lows:

"SECTION 3. Fish variety classification. -
For purposes of this Ordinance, different fish
varieties are hereby classified as follows:

First class: Ahaan, bahaulo, bañgus, katambak,
kitong, mahinlo, malasugi, mambulaw,
mamsa, manambo, nukos, pañgalwan,
pugapo, sandatan, tañgigi, and
others of similar class variety
and quality;

Fancy or delicacy variety: Kasili and pansat;

Second class: Alimaño, bansikol, barilis, bilong-
bilang, bolis, buraw, hasahasa,
lambarok, lusod, marapati, pasayan,
tamarong, tumbaw, ulisi, and others
of similar class variety and
quality;

Third class: Aguk-ok, bangsi, baruñgoy, bulinaw, burot,
dangit, giñgaw, gurami, halwan, iho,
kiampá, libgaw, mangsi, pagi, saguksok,
sawasid, ubod, and others of similar
class variety and quality."


SECTION 2. Effectivity. - This Ordinance shall take effect fifteen days after its approval.

ENACTED, August 22, 1974.



"CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY."




