RESOLUTION NO. 175

"WHEREAS, past experiences have shown the destructiveness of conflagration in terms of human lives and valuable properties in both public and private sectors which could have been minimized, if not, prevented had there been adequate emergency fire control equipment in the localities that were affected;

"WHEREAS, in the pursuit of the current program of the Government to improve fire services to the people and in line with its policy to protect public buildings, equipment, documents and other properties from the hazards of fire, the Commander of III PC Zone in his radiogram of September 23, 1974, addressed to the Chiefs of the Fire Departments of Tacloban, Ormoc and Tanauan, among others, considered it imperative that emergency fire control equipment be installed in all offices of the national and local governments;

"WHEREAS, it has become urgent that we amend further Ordinance No. IV, series of 1956, so as to include all government offices in the City of Ormoc in the requirement for them to install in their respective establishments at least one fire extinguisher each;

"NOW, THEREFORE, on motion of Councilor Porcadilla, seconded by Councilor Mendola;

"RESOLVED, to adopt:

ORDINANCE NO. 19

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING FURTHER ORDINANCE NO. IV, SERIES OF 1956, SO AS TO INCLUDE ALL GOVERNMENT OFFICES TO BE REQUIRED TO INSTALL AT LEAST ONE FIRE EXTINGUISHER EACH.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Municipal Board of Ormoc City,
That:

SECTION 1. Title. - The title of Ordinance No. IV, series of 1956, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING ALL BUSINESS ESTABLISHMENTS WITH A CAPITAL OF P500.00 EACH OR MORE AND ALL GOVERNMENT OFFICES IN THE CITY OF ORMOC TO INSTALL AT LEAST ONE FIRE EXTINGUISHER EACH.

SECTION 2. Section 1 of Ordinance No. IV, series of 1956, as amended by Ordinance No. 69, series of 1968, is hereby amended further to read as follows:

"SECTION 1. Every person, firm, company or corporation running a business establishment or operating and maintaining a store or stores with a capital of ₱500.00 or more and every government office in the City of Ormoc are hereby required to install in their respective establishments, stores or offices fire extinguishers, the size and number of which is to be determined according to the size of the establishment, store or office and the volume of the business, but in no case shall the number be less than one fire extinguisher each."


SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval.


"RESOLVED, FURTHER, to furnish a copy of this resolution-ordinance each to all Government offices, through their respective heads, in the City of Ormoc;

"CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY."




