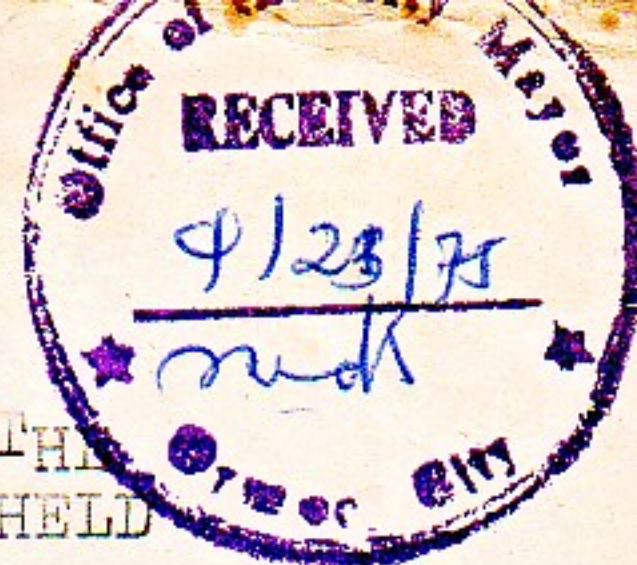

ORDINANCE NO. 16

AN ORDINANCE RENUMBERING ALL ORDINANCES BEGINNING WITH
ORDINANCE NO. 14, SERIES OF 1973, AS AMENDED, MORE
PARTICULARLY KNOWN AS THE "ORMOC CITY TAX CODE OF
1973" TO BE DESIGNATED AS ORDINANCE NO. 1, AND, THERE-
AFTER, SUBSEQUENT ORDINANCES TO BE CONSECUTIVELY RE-
NUMBERED FROM 2 UP, AND AMENDING CERTAIN ARTICLES
AND SECTIONS OF CHAPTER 2 UNDER TITLE 2 OF THE TAX
CODE IN PURSUANCE OF THE DIRECTIVE OF THE DEPARTMENT
OF FINANCE DATED DECEMBER 12, 1974

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Municipal Board of Ormoc City,
That:

SECTION 1. Renumbering of all Ordinances beginning
with Ordinance No. 14, series of 1973, as amended, to be
designated as Ordinance No. 1. - All Ordinances are here-
by renumbered beginning with Ordinance No. 14, series of
1973, as amended by Ordinance Nos. 1, 2 and 8, series of
1974, more particularly known as the "Ormoc City Tax Code
of 1973" which shall be designated as Ordinance No. 1 and,
thereafter, subsequent Ordinances shall be consecutively
renumbered to 2 up regardless of their annual series, as
provided hereunder as follows, to wit:

SECTION 2. Amendment to Title 2, Chapter 2, Article 2 of the Ormoc City Tax Code of 1973. - Title 2, Chapter 2, Article 2 of the Ormoc City Tax Code of 1973 is hereby amended by inserting a new section between Sections 2.2.2.1 and 2.2.2.2 to be known as Section 2.2.2.1-A which shall read as follows:

"SEC. 2.2.2.1-A. Tax on business establishments, etc. - There shall be imposed an annual tax of the gross receipts on all establishments principally rendering or offering to render services, such as repair and welding shops, service stations, painting shops, plastic lamination, photostatic, white/blue printing, recopying or duplicating services, photographic studios, tailor and dress shops, laundry shops, beauty parlors, battery charging shops, barber shops, assaying laboratories, advertising agencies, collecting agencies, funeral parlors, massage or therapeutic clinics, construction and/or repair shops of motor vehicles, animal-drawn vehicles, bicycles and/or tricycles, goldsmiths and silversmiths, shops for shear-animals, lathe machine shops, vaciador shops, upholstery shops, vulcanizing shops, stables, garages, parking lots, and public warehouses and bodegas;

"Shops for planing or surfacing and recutting of lumber and sawmills under contract to saw or cut logs belonging to others; dyeing establishments; milliners and hatters; blacksmiths; slendering and body building saloons; furniture repair shops; shoe repair shops; house and/or sign painters; escort services; gasoline, diesel fuel service stations; irrigation contractors; plumbing installations; photography studios;

"Booking offices for local exchange (except imported films; brokerage; drilling apparatus, drafting services; private hospitals, medical and/or dental clinics; public ferries; purchasing warehouses and bodegas; purchasing agents and/or purchasing agencies; recapping plants; rental of equipment, furniture, bicycles, vehicles, suits, skates, trucks, etc.; watch repair center and shops; wood-carving handicraft shops;"

SECTION 3. Amendment to Item T-22 of Title 2, Chapter 2, Article 3, Section 1 of the Ormoc City Tax Code of 1973.
- Item T-22 of Section 1, under Title 2, Chapter 2, Article 3 of the Ormoc City Tax Code of 1973 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"T. On Amusement Places. -

"x x x x x x.

"22. Theaters and cinema houses:	<u>Per Annum</u>
"With balcony and orchestra with seating capacity of less than 500 persons	₱ 90.00
"With balcony and orchestra with seating capacity from 500 to 999 persons	100.00
"With balcony and orchestra with seating capacity of 1,000 persons and above	150.00
"With loge, balcony and orchestra ..	200.00
"An additional tax not exceeding fifty percent (50%) of the rates hereinabove fixed shall be imposed on theaters and cinematographs which are air-conditioned."	


SECTION 4. Effectivity. - This Ordinance shall take effect fifteen days after its approval.

ENACTED, April 17, 1975.



"CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY."




