**RESOLUTION NO. 384**

"WHEREAS, the 1977 Ormoc City Festival celebration is already at high gear and it becomes imperative that some-  
portions of certain city streets within the immediate vi-  
cinity of the festival grounds must have to be closed to  
vehicular traffic for the safety of pedestrians in the area  
for the duration (June 20-July 4, 1977) most especially at  
night time;

"WHEREAS, after a study on the matter the following  
sections of streets have been duly considered for tempora-  
ry closure and, as a matter of fact, some of them have al-  
ready been closed to vehicular traffic: (a) J. Navarro St.:  
from its corner on P. Burgos St. up to its opposite corner  
on C. Aviles St.; (b) P. Burgos St.: from its corner on J.  
Navarro St. up to the gate of the DLGCD office; and (c) to  
be closed to heavy trucks and buses only, C. Aviles St.:  
from its corner on San Pablo St. to its opposite corner on  
Bonifacio St.;

"NOW, THEREFORE, on motion of Kagawad Samson, unani-  
mously seconded;

"RESOLVED, to adopt:

**ORDINANCE NO. 10**

AN ORDINANCE TEMPORARILY CLOSING TO VEHICULAR TRAFFIC  
PORTIONS OF CERTAIN CITY STREETS FOR THE DURATION  
OF THE ORMOC CITY FESTIVAL CELEBRATION FROM JUNE  
20 TO JULY 4, 1977, PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIO-  
LATIONS THEREOF, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Sangguniang Bayan of Ormoc City,  
That:

SEC. 1. Temporary closure of vehicular traffic. - For



the safety of pedestrians during this year's celebration of the Ormoc City Festival the following portions of city streets are hereby closed to vehicular traffic temporarily for the period from June 20 up to and including July 4, 1977, only:

- (a) J. Navarro Street: from corner of P. Burgos Street to corner of C. Aviles Street;
- (b) P. Burgos Street: from corner of J. Navarro Street to ~~the~~ gate of the DLGCD office; and
- (c) C. Aviles Street: (to be closed to heavy trucks and buses only) - from corner of San Pablo Street to corner of Bonifacio Street.

SEC. 2. Penalty for violation. - Any violation of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be punishable by a fine of not less than twenty-five pesos or an imprisonment of not less than five days, or both such fine and imprisonment at the discretion of the court.

SEC. 3. Effectivity. - This Ordinance takes effect as of June 20, 1977.

ENACTED, June 21, 1977.

"RESOLVED, FURTHER, to furnish a copy of this resolution-ordinance each to His Honor, the City Mayor, the Trafcon Officer, PC, Camp Downes, the City Judge, the Chief of Police, and the Registrar, LTC, all in Ormoc City;
