RESOLUTION NO. 280

"WHEREAS, Faustino Ablen, as Ormoc's unwritten history goes, spent the best years of his life in leading his fellow-Ormocanos in the resistance movement striving to free themselves from the Spanish oppressors' rule in this part of the archipelago shortly before the turn of the century;

"WHEREAS, Faustino Ablen etched an exemplary record of action as a resistance leader notably in the fields of battle risking his dear life with a handful of compatriots impotently armed with bolos against the mighty weapons of the Spanish royal force;

"WHEREAS, as a fitting tribute to the memory of a man imbued with the spirit of patriotism, to a man of courage, valor and bravery, and to a man whose name is moulded in the early unwritten history of Ormoc as the champion of the resistance movement in his adherence to the ideals of justice and liberty, a public street be now named after Faustino Ablen;

"NOW, THEREFORE, on motion of Kagawad Cristobal S. Mendola; seconded by Kagawad Aberilla;

"RESOLVED, to adopt:

ORDINANCE NO. 6

AN ORDINANCE NAMING THE STREET AT COGON COMBADO
STARTING FROM THE CITY ENGINEERING COMPOUND
TO LILIA AVENUE "FAUSTINO ABLEN STREET"

BE IT ENACTED, by the Sangguniang Bayan of Ormoc City,
That:

SECTION 1. Naming of Faustino Ablen Street. - The city street at Cogon Combado, Ormoc City, starting from the City Engineering Compound up to Lilia Avenue, is hereby named "Faustino Ablen Street".


SECTION 2. Effectivity. - This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval.

ENACTED, February 22, 1977.



"CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY."


