

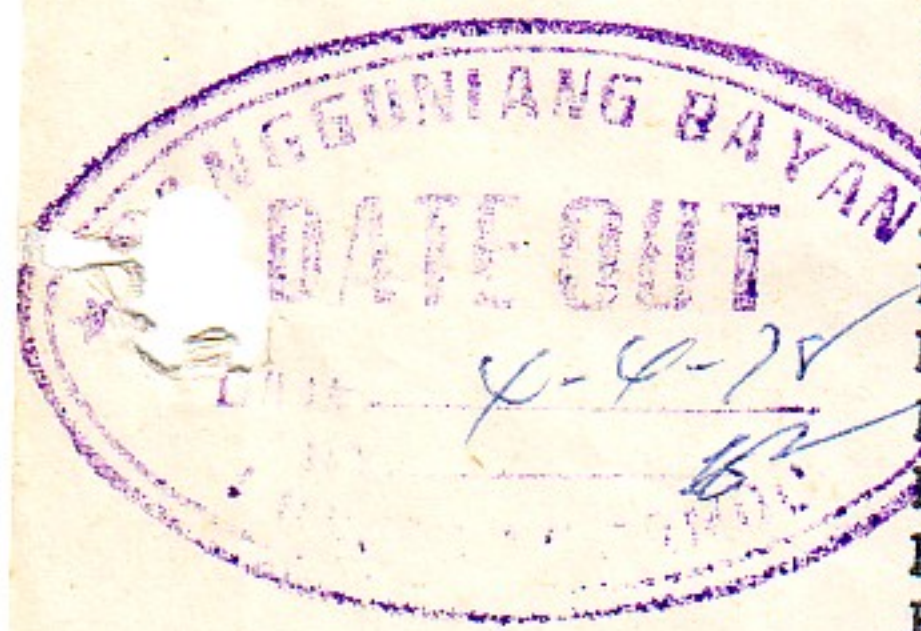

RESOLUTION NO. 537

The City Sanggunian, on motion of Kagawad Besabella,
seconded by Kagawad Mejia;

"RESOLVED, to adopt:

ORDINANCE NO. 19

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING SUFFICIENT WORKING SPACE FOR
AUTO REPAIR, MACHINE, WELDING AND VULCANIZING SHOPS
AND THE LIKE AND PROVIDING PENALTY FOR VIOLATION
THEREOF.

BE IT ENACTED, by the Sangguniang Panlungsod ng Ormoc,
That:

SECTION 1. Title.-- This Ordinance shall be known as the
Shop Working Space Ordinance of Ormoc City.

SECTION 2. Shop Working Space Requirement.-- Before opera-
ting any auto repair shop, machine shop, welding shop, uphol-
tery shop, vulcanizing shop, and the like the proprietors o r
operators thereof are hereby required to provide sufficient
working space, other than the city roads or streets. Mayor's
permits, business permits, and other related permits shall not
be issued unless the following required working spaces b e
provided:

a) Auto repair shop, not less than 500 sq. m.

- b) Machine shop, not less than 500 sq. m.
- c) Welding shop accepting cars and trucks for welding undetached parts, not less than 500 sq. m.
- d) Upholstery shop accepting cars and automobiles, and the like, for upholstery services - 500 sq. m.
- e) Other upholstery shop - 100 sq. m.
- f) Other welding shop - 200 sq. m.
- g) Vulcanizing shop - at least 100 sq.m.

Providing, however, that auto repair and machine shops which could accommodate at least five trucks together at any given time shall likewise be qualified under the provisions of this section, the space required notwithstanding.

SECTION 3. It shall be unlawful for any proprietor or owner of business covered by this Ordinance to allow any of their mechanics, welders, and/or any of their employees, workers, and laborers to conduct or make repairs of any vehicle, or the welding of any part thereof, nor shall they carry on their business on any portion or part of the city street or streets. Any existing shop or shops covered by the provisions of this Ordinance which may be found to have no sufficient working space is liable under this Ordinance and its permit to operate the business shall automatically be cancelled and revoked, and be subject to the penalty herein prescribed.

SECTION 4. Penalty.- Violations of any provision of this Ordinance shall subject the offender to a fine of not less than FIVE HUNDRED PESOS (P500.00), or to an imprisonment of not more than one month, or both, at the discretion of the court.

SECTION 5. Repeal.- Any existing ordinance or provision thereof inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed and/or amended accordingly.

SECTION 6. Separability.- If any part of parts of this Ordinance shall be declared unconstitutional or ultra-vires, said declaration shall not invalidate the whole Ordinance.

SECTION 7. Effectivity.- This Ordinance shall take effect one month after its approval.
