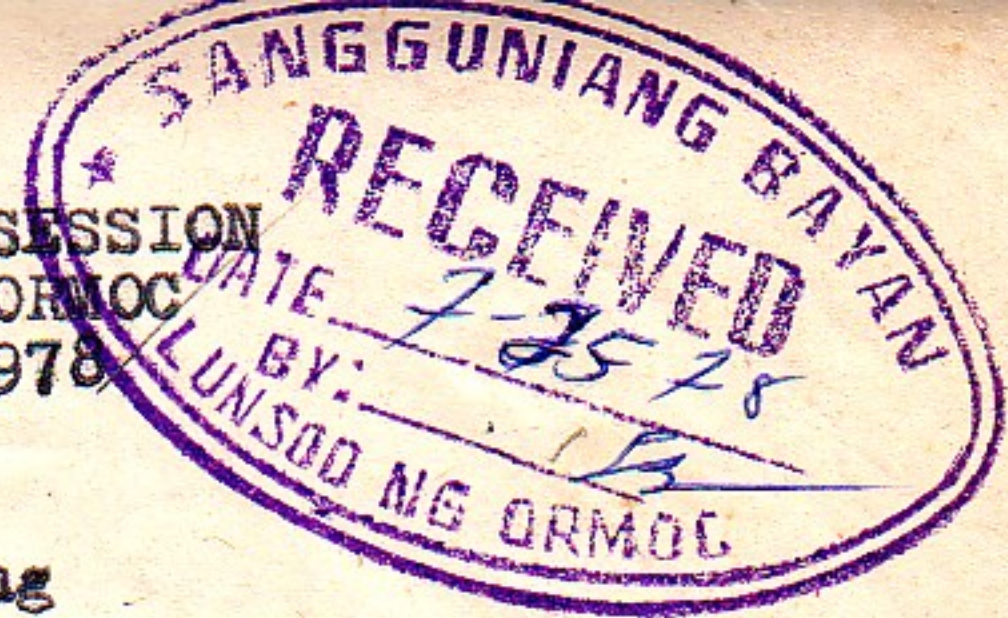

"RESOLVED, to adopt:

ORDINANCE NO. 20 ✓

AN ORDINANCE SPECIFYING CITES FOR BICYCLE JOY-RIDING AND TRAINING, PROMULGATING RULES AND REGULATIONS THEREFOR, AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Sangguniang Panlungsod ng Ormoc,

That:

SECTION 1. Title. - This Ordinance shall be known as the "ORMOC CITY BICYCLE ORDINANCE OF 1978".

SECTION 2. Rules and Regulations. - For the general safety of cyclists, bicycle riders, motorists, pedestrians and the general public the following rules and regulations on bicycles are hereby promulgated:

1. All bicycle owners within the territorial jurisdiction of Ormoc City are hereby required to register their bicycle units, whether for rent or for personal use, every year with the Office of the City Treasurer.

2. The City Treasurer is hereby empowered or authorized to register any bicycle unit presented to his office for registration and, for this purpose, shall impose and collect a fee of ₱10.00 per unit per annum on bicycles for rent and ₱8.50 per unit per annum on bicycles for personal use and shall issue upon said registration the corresponding plate numbers thereto: Provided, however, that registration or re-registration of bicycles shall be within the month of January of each year and: Provided, further, that bicycle units newly acquired shall be registered within a month from the time of acquisition.

3. The Office of the City Treasurer shall provide a distinctive mark duly approved by the City Sanggunian on the plate numbers for bicycles for rent so as to give them a distinguishing feature from those of bicycles for personal use.

4. The Office of the City Treasurer shall keep a record of the names and respective addresses of bicycle owners for reference and for other uses or purposes.

SECTION 3. Places and premises where bicycle joy-riding and training are allowed. - Bicycle joy-riding and/or training shall only be allowed within the following places:

- a) Inside public plazas where the safety of the rider and the general public could not be endangered;
- b) Inside private premises where the life and limb of the rider or riders and the general public could not be impaired or prejudiced.

SECTION 4. Prohibition and advice. - It shall be unlawful for any person, specially minors, to engage in bicycle joy-riding or training on or along any street of the city. Owners of bicycle units, whether for rent or for personal use, are required to advise and admonish the users, riders or lessees of their bicycles about this prohibition.

SECTION 5. Definition of terms. - For purposes of this Ordinance, the following terms are hereby defined:

- a) Joy-riding shall mean to be the act of riding on a bicycle by a person or persons along city streets for fun and without any apparent or predeterminate destination.
- b) Owner/s of bicycle for rent shall mean to be the person or persons who are offering their bicycle units to the public for rent or for a fixed amount for a given period of time.

SECTION 6. Penalty for violation. - (a) Any violation of the provisions of this ordinance shall subject the offender to a fine of not less than fifty pesos or an imprisonment of not more than five days, or both such fine and imprisonment at the discretion of the proper court. If the offending joy-rider is found to be a minor, i.e., below 15 years old, the owner of the bicycle used shall be fined in the amount aforementioned.

(b) Any person who owns a bicycle but fails to register the same in pursuance of Rule 2 under Section 2 hereof shall be subject to a fine of twenty pesos for not registering within one month after acquisition and twenty pesos for not re-registering the unit in addition to the required registration fee.

SECTION 7. Repeal. - Item "a" under Section 3.2.4.1 of the Ormoc City Revenue Code of 1977 is hereby amended; and any provision of any other ordinance or local law found to be inconsistent herewith is hereby repealed and/or modified accordingly.

SECTION 8. Separability. - Any provision or provisions of this ordinance declared to be unconstitutional or ultra-vires the said declaration shall not invalidate the whole of this Ordinance and the remaining provisions shall be deemed as enforceable.


SECTION 9. Effectivity. - This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval.




