

RESOLUTION NO. 310

"The Sangguniang Panlungsod ng Ormoc on motion of Kagawad Subingsubing, seconded by Kagawad Hermosilla, be it

"RESOLVED, to adopt:

ORDINANCE NO. 10

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE SALE OF ALL BRANDS OF VOLATILE RUBBER CEMENT IN THE CITY OF ORMOC, PROVIDING PENALTY FOR VIOLATION THEREOF, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED, by the Sangguniang Panlungsod ng Ormoc, That:

SECTION 1. Title. - This Ordinance shall be known as "An Ordinance Regulating the Sale of all Brands of Volatile Rubber Cement in the City of Ormoc."

SECTION 2. Definition of Terms. - For purposes of this Ordinance the following terms are hereby defined:

1. Rubber cement, or in the dialect Rugby - a kind of cement which is commonly used to paste rubber materials as shoes, slippers and the like.
2. Addict - a person under the influenced of drugs.
3. Minors - those whose ages are between 7 to 18 years old.
4. Shoemakers - individuals who make and repair shoes for their livelihood.
5. Manager or Proprietor - are head of the store or hardware that will sell the said rubber cement or rugby.

(RES. NO. 310, ORD. NO. 10)

SECTION 3. It shall be unlawful for any person, individual or any store or hardware, shoemaker or shoe repair shop to sell rubber cement or rugby to minors;

SECTION 4. Penalty - Any violation of the provision of this Ordinance shall subject the offender, manager or proprietor in case of store or hardware, shoemaker or shoe repair shop, to a fine of not less than two hundred pesos (P200.00) or an imprisonment of not more than one (1) month or both such fine and imprisonment at the discretion of the court.

SECTION 5. Repeal - Any existing ordinance or provision thereof inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed and/or amended accordingly.

SECTION 6. Separability. - If any part or parts of this Ordinance shall be declared unconstitutional of ultra-vires, said declaration shall not invalidate the whole of this Ordinance.


SECTION 7. Effectivity. - This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval.

"CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY."




